Crown (dental restoration) A crown is typically bonded to the tooth by dental cement. A crown may be needed when a large dental cavity threatens the health of a tooth. Crowns are used to improve the strength or appearance of teeth and to halt deterioration. The crownlay In dentistry, a crown or a dental cap is a type of dental restoration that completely caps or encircles a tooth or dental implant. They can be made from various materials, which are usually fabricated using indirect methods. While beneficial to dental health, the procedure and materials can be costly. The key comparison between them is the amount and part of the tooth that they cover. An inlay will incorporate the pits and fissures of a tooth, mainly encompassing the chewing surface between the cusps. An onlay will involve one or more cusps being covered. For instance, trauma, infection, radiation, fluorosis, amelogenesis imperfecta, and molar incisor hypomineralization are among the causing factors of enamel hypocalcification. 7a3c055eda

Inlays and onlays in molars or premolars, when the tooth has experienced too much damage to support a basic filling, but not so much damage that a crown is necessary. In dentistry, inlays and onlays are used to fill cavities, and then cemented in place in the tooth. This is an alternative to a direct restoration, made out of composite, amalgam or glass ionomer, that is built up within the mouth 7a3c055eda

They are often used to correct underbites, as well as malocclusions, overbites, open bites, gaps, deep bites, cross bites, crooked teeth, and various other flaws of the teeth and jaw. Atraumatic restorative treatment It does not use rotary dental instruments (dental drills) to prepare the tooth and can be performed in settings with no access to dental equipment. cleaning out tooth decay (dental caries) from teeth using only hand instruments (dental hatchet and spoon-excavator) and placing a filling. No drilling or local anaesthetic injections are required. ART can be used for small, medium and deep cavities (where decay has not reached the tooth nerve dental pulp) caused by dental caries. ART is considered a conservative approach, not only because it removes the decayed tissue with hand instruments, avoiding removing more tissue than necessary which preserves as much tooth structure as possible, but also because it avoids pulp irritation and minimises patient discomfort. The most common method of crowning a tooth involves taking a dental impression of a tooth prepared by a dentist, then fabricating the crown outside of the mouth. The crown can then be inserted at a subsequent dental appointment. This indirect method of tooth restoration allows use of strong restorative material requiring time-consuming fabrication under intense heat, such as casting metal or firing porcelain, that would not be possible inside the mouth. Dental restoration Fillings may also be used to replace or seal tooth structure around dental implants or after more extensive procedures such as root-canal therapy. Materials for direct fillings commonly include amalgam (metal) or tooth-colored composite and glass-ionomer, while indirect restorations may use

ceramics, metal alloys or porcelain for greater durability and structural support. There are two broad categories of fillings: direct restorations, placed and shaped directly inside a cleaned cavity in a single dental visit, and indirect restorations (such as inlays or onlays), which are fabricated outside the mouth (often in a laboratory) and then cemented into the tooth. and morphology of tooth structure lost due to decay (caries), trauma, or wear. 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Washers are usually metal or plastic. High-quality bolted joints require hardened steel washers to prevent the loss of pre-load due to brinelling after the torque is applied. Washers are also important for preventing galvanic corrosion, particularly by insulating steel screws from aluminium surfaces. They may also be used in rotating applications, as a bearing. A thrust washer is used when a rolling element bearing is not needed either from a cost-performance perspective or due to space restraints. Enamel hypocalcification Their life cycle, known as amelogenesis, is divided into six stages: morphogenic, organizing, formative, maturative, protective, and desmolytic. To improve the bonding effectiveness Enamel is the outermost layer of the tooth which serves as a protective layer from physical, thermal, and chemical damage. Enamel hypocalcification is the inadequate deposition of inorganic ions, resulting in the appearance of translucency, white-chalky spots, and yellow-brown discoloration on the surface of the tooth associated with increased sensitivity and a higher risk of developing dental caries. Ameloblasts are the cells that produce the enamel. Enamel mineralization occurs during the maturation stage. Hence, defects in the maturation stage result in hypocalcification or hypomineralization. options, the bonding strength is affected by the amount of sound enamel available and should be carefully considered

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
