Treatment depends on the severity of the symptoms, with mild cases possibly only requiring rest and localized icing. Options for presentations with severe sepsis include intravenous antibiotics, surgical irrigation of the bursa, and bursectomy. 898e55efbd painful urination, 898e55efbd In adults, the vagina is largely protected from trauma due to the protective function of the mons pubis and labia majora. This protection is lacking in girls who lack a protective fat layer to protect the vagina. Vaginal trauma can occur when something is inserted into the vagina, for example, a sharp object causing penetrating trauma. Vaginal

trauma can occur as a result of a painful sexual experience or sexual abuse. Vaginal trauma can occur in children as a result of a straddle injury. Most of these, though distressing, are not serious injuries.

This muscular defect typically results in myalgia (muscle pain), muscle weakness (reduced muscle force), or premature muscle fatigue (initially normal, but declining muscle force). Muscle cramps, stiffness, spasm, and contracture can also be associated with myopathy. Myopathy experienced over a long period (chronic) may result in the muscle becoming an abnormal size, such as muscle atrophy (abnormally small) or a pseudoathletic appearance (abnormally large).

Amputation Gait deviations are nominally referred to as any variation of standard human gait, typically manifesting as a coping mechanism in response to an anatomical impairment. Without the anatomical structure and neuromechanical control of the removed leg segment, amputees must use alternative compensatory strategies to walk efficiently

Multiple epiphyseal dysplasia In MED, this process is defective. There are Multiple epiphyseal dysplasia (MED), also known as Fairbank's disease, is a rare genetic disorder (dominant form: 1 in 10,000 births) that affects the growing ends of bones. Their x-rays show small and irregular ossification centers, most apparent in the hips and knees. Long bones normally elongate by expansion of cartilage in the growth plate (epiphyseal plate) near their ends. experience joint pain and fatigue after exercising. As it expands outward from the growth plate, the cartilage mineralizes and hardens to become bone (ossification) 898e55efbd

== Types == 898e55efbd Children with autosomal dominant MED experience joint pain and fatigue after exercising. Their x-rays show small and irregular ossification centers, most apparent in the hips and knees. There are very small capital femoral epiphyses and hypoplastic, poorly formed acetabular roofs. A waddling gait may develop. Knees have metaphyseal widening and irregularity while hands have brachydactyly (short fingers) and proximal metacarpal rounding. Flat feet are very common. It usually occurs as a result of stress and physical exertion during capture and restraint. 898e55efbd bleeding, 898e55efbd The advantage over traditional open surgery is that the joint does not have to be opened up fully. For knee arthroscopy only two small incisions are made, one for the arthroscope and one for the surgical instruments to be used in the knee cavity. This reduces recovery time and may increase the rate of success due to less trauma to the connective tissue. It has gained popularity due to evidence of faster recovery times with less scarring, because of the smaller incisions. Amputation Amputation has also been used as a tactic in war and acts of terrorism; it may also occur as a war injury. In some cultures and religions, minor amputations or mutilations are considered a ritual accomplishment. In some cases, it is carried out on individuals as a preventive surgery for such problems. A special case is that of congenital amputation, a congenital disorder, where fetal limbs have been cut off by constrictive bands. A prosthesis or a bioelectric replantation may restore sensation of the amputated limb. The oldest evidence of this practice comes from a skeleton found buried in Liang Tebo cave, East Kalimantan, Indonesian Borneo dating back to at least 31,000 years ago, where it was done when the amputee was a young child. medical illness, or surgery. == Overall health care == 898e55efbd In some instances, a severe injury occurs and requires immediate medical attention, especially if the bleeding will not stop. Vaginal trauma also occurs during an episiotomy and vaginal childbirth. Hereditary multiple exostoses The vast majority of affected individuals become clinically manifest by the time they reach adolescence. They are also known as osteochondromas. Intra-articular osteochondromas of the hip can induce limitation of range of motion, joint pain and Hereditary multiple osteochondromas (HMO), also known as hereditary multiple exostoses, is a disorder characterized by the development of multiple benign osteocartilaginous masses (exostoses) in relation to the ends of long bones of the lower limbs such as the femurs and tibias and of the upper limbs such as the humeri and forearm bones. The incidence of hereditary multiple exostoses is around 1 in 50,000 individuals. Additional sites of occurrence include on flat bones such as the pelvic bone and scapula. The risk that people with hereditary multiple osteochondromas have a 1 in 20 to 1 in 200 lifetime risk of developing sarcomas. The distribution and number of these exostoses show a wide diversity among affected individuals. the knee. Hereditary multiple osteochondromas is the preferred term used by the World Health Organization. Forearm involvement in HMO is considerable. A small percentage of affected individuals are at risk for development of sarcomas as a result of malignant transformation. Exostoses usually present during childhood 898e55efbd

In most episodes of low back pain a specific underlying cause is not identified or even looked for: the pain is believed to be due to mechanical problems such as muscle or joint strain. If the pain does not go away with conservative treatment or if it is accompanied by "red flag" symptoms such as unexplained weight loss, fever,

or significant problems with feeling or movement, further testing may be needed to look for a serious underlying problem. In most cases, imaging tools such as CT scans are not useful or recommended for low back pain that lasts less than 6 weeks (with no red flags) and carry their own risks.
