In this article, unless otherwise specified, hyperstimulation will refer to hyperstimulation as part of IVF. The term luteinizing comes from the Latin "luteus", meaning "yellow". This is in reference to the corpus luteum, which is a mass of cells that forms in an ovary after an ovum (egg) has been discharged. The corpus luteum is so named because it often has a distinctive yellow color. The process of forming the corpus luteum is known as "luteinization", and thus the hormone that triggers this process is termed the "luteinizing" hormone. == Etymology and nomenclature == Many mammals used in commercial agriculture, such as cattle and sheep, may have their estrous cycles artificially controlled with hormonal medications for optimum productivity. The male equivalent, seen primarily in ruminants, is called rut. == Patterns == == Scope == Assisted reproductive technology also exists, like IVF, some of which involve alternative methods of fertilization, which do not involve sexual intercourse; the fertilization of the ovum may be achieved by artificial insemination methods. Systems of fertility awareness rely on observation of changes in one or more of the primary fertility signs (basal body temperature, cervical mucus, and cervical position), tracking menstrual cycle length and identifying the fertile window based on this information, or both. Other signs may also be observed: these include breast tenderness and mittelschmerz (ovulation pains), urine analysis strips known as ovulation predictor kits (OPKs), and microscopic examination of saliva or cervical fluid. Also available are computerized fertility monitors.

Luteinizing hormone In males, where LH had also been called interstitial cell stimulating hormone (ICSH), it stimulates Leydig cell production of testosterone. The production of LH is regulated by gonadotropin-releasing hormone (GnRH) from the hypothalamus. It acts synergistically with follicle-stimulating hormone (FSH). In females, an acute rise of LH known as an LH surge, triggers ovulation and development of the corpus luteum. ovulation. The oral and injectable methods are by far the most popular. 3% rate or less. Hormonal contraception is highly effective: when taken on the prescribed schedule, users of steroid hormone methods experience pregnancy rates of less than 1% per year. Currently available methods can only be used by women; the development of a male hormonal contraceptive is an active research area. methods work by suppressing ovulation and thickening cervical mucus; while progestogen-only methods reduce the frequency of ovulation, most rely more heavily. Hormonal contraception refers to birth control methods that act on the endocrine system. The original hormonal method—the combined oral contraceptive pill—was first marketed as a contraceptive in 1960 58b4fad33a

There are two main types of hormonal contraceptive formulations: combined methods which contain both an estrogen and a progestin, and progestogen-only methods which contain only progesterone or one of its synthetic analogues (progestins). Long-acting reversible contraceptives They include hormonal and non-hormonal intrauterine devices (IUDs) and subdermal hormonal contraceptive implants. timeframe may be extended if the date of ovulation is known; the copper IUD must be inserted within 5 days of ovulation. They are the most effective reversible methods of contraception because their efficacy is not reliant on patient compliance. The failure rates of IUDs and implants is less than 1% per year. Human reproduction reproduction to be achieved, an individual must undergo puberty first, requiring ovulation in females and the spermarche in males to have occurred prior to engaging Human sexual reproduction, to produce offspring, begins with fertilization. Successful reproduction typically involves sexual intercourse between a healthy, sexually mature and fertile male and female. During sexual intercourse, sperm cells are ejaculated into the vagina through the penis, resulting in fertilization of an ovum to form a zygote 58b4fad33a

== Terminology == 58b4fad33a Tribe Hominini includes: the extant genus Homo, which comprises only one extant species — modern human (*Homo sapiens*), and numerous extinct human species; and the extant genus Pan, which includes two extant species, chimpanzees and bonobos. Tribe Gorillini (gorillas) contains one extant genus, *Gorilla*, with two extant species, with variants, and one known extinct genus. Alternatively, the genus Pan is considered by some to belong, instead of to a subtribe Panina, to its own separate tribe, (so-called) "Panini," which would be a third tribe for Hominae. 58b4fad33a ==

typically lasts 4 weeks (28 days, range 24–35 days) and consists of a follicular phase, ovulation, and a luteal phase followed by either menstruation or pregnancy, the anovulatory cycle has cycle lengths of varying degrees. In many circumstances, menstrual intervals are prolonged, reaching 35–180 days (oligomenorrhea) or even longer (amenorrhea). In other cases, menstruation may be fairly regular (eumenorrhea), more frequent (intervals of less than 21 days) or there may be a loss of menstrual pattern (menorrhagia, dysfunctional uterine bleeding). 58b4fad33a

Estrous cycle Estrous cycles start after sexual maturity in females and are interrupted by anestrous phases, otherwise known as "rest" phases, or by pregnancies. Typically, estrous cycles repeat until death. These cycles are widely variable in duration and frequency depending on the species. However, various incidents of spontaneous ovulation have been documented in the The estrous cycle (US-EN;) or oestrous cycle (UK-EN;) (from Latin oestrus 'frenzy', originally from Ancient Greek οἶστρος (oîstros) 'gadfly') is a set of recurring physiological changes induced by reproductive hormones in females of mammalian subclass Theria. characterized as an induced ovulator, since coitus induces ovulation.
