S. aureus usually acts as a commensal of the human microbiota, it can also become an opportunistic pathogen, being a common cause of skin infections including abscesses, respiratory infections such as sinusitis, and food poisoning. It is often positive for catalase and nitrate reduction and is a facultative anaerobe, meaning that it can grow without oxygen
