Rosen and Bailey reduced *P. mexicana* and other shortfin mollies to synonyms of *P. sphenops*, a similar species which occurs throughout much of the range of *P. mexicana*. In 1971, Schultz and Miller restored *P. butleri* to species rank on the grounds of partial reproductive and geographic isolation. Two years later, Menzel and Darnell resurrected *P. mexicana* from synonymy of *P. sphenops*, noting that it differs from *P. sphenops* in ways similar to *P. butleri*.
