1969 NBA Finals It was immediately evident that West's swollen leg would not heal until The 1969 NBA World Championship Series to determine the champion of the 1968-69 NBA season was played between the Los Angeles Lakers and Boston Celtics. They remain the only 4th seed team to win the Finals and the second-lowest seeded team overall to win the Finals after the Houston Rockets in 1995. Ultimately, the Celtics won the championship in seven games – the last championship of the Bill Russell dynasty – and is considered one of the great upsets in NBA

history. The Lakers were heavily favored due to the presence of three formidable stars: Elgin Baylor, Wilt Chamberlain, and Jerry West. In addition, Boston was an aging team; they made the playoffs as the fourth place team in the Eastern Division, and were not favored to make it to the finals; no four seed had ever made the Finals before the Celtics did so here. Modern fixation Anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction (ACL reconstruction) is a surgical tissue graft replacement of the anterior cruciate ligament, located in the knee, to restore its function after an injury f981fade53

The symptoms of strain are pain and interference with activities and difficulty generating strength due to pain. The actual strength of the muscle is not affected unless there is a complete rupture. The signs of a strain include tenderness and pain with stretch of the muscle. Contusion,

The anterior cruciate ligament is one of the four main ligaments of the knee, providing 85% of the restraining force to anterior tibial displacement at 30 and 90° of knee flexion. The ACL is the most frequently injured ligament in the knee. The patellar ligament is often used, since The anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) is one of the cruciate ligaments in the human knee. The two most common sources for tissue are the patellar ligament and the hamstrings tendon. This name is fitting because the ACL crosses the posterior cruciate ligament to form an "X". It

is composed of strong, fibrous material and assists in controlling excessive motion by limiting mobility of the joint. The two ligaments are called "cruciform" ligaments, as they are arranged in a crossed formation

Angelo DiBernardo Born in Argentina, he played for the United States national team and also represented them at the 1984 Summer Olympics. In Angelo DiBernardo (born May 16, 1956) is a former soccer player who played professionally in the North American Soccer League and Major Indoor Soccer League. Medial patellofemoral ligament An orthopedic surgeon replaces the injured ligament with either a hamstring tendon from the patient or from a donor. The medial patellofemoral ligament (MPFL) is one of several ligaments on the medial aspect of the knee. The ligament itself extends from the femur to the superomedial patella, and its shape is similar to a trapezoid. It keeps the patella in place, but its main function is to prevent lateral displacement of the patella. lower half of the body, and an IV for sedation. The Anterior Cruciate Ligament (ACL) is the ligament that keeps the knee

stable. ACL damage is a very common injury, especially among athletes. ACL Reconstruction surgery is a common intervention. There are approximately 200,000 ACL tears occurring annually and between 100,000 and 300,000 reconstruction surgeries will be performed each year in the United States. Around \$500 million health care dollar will come from ACL injuries. ACL injuries can be categorized into groups- contact and non-contact based on the nature of the injury. Contact injuries occur when a person or object come into contact with the knee causing the ligament to tear. ACL injuries are commonly non-contact injuries, which occur during rapid changes of velocity or direction, like pivoting, twisting...
