Letters of credence and of recall are traditionally written in French, the lingua franca of diplomacy. However, they may also be written in the official language of the sending state. 24d30bfbf8 Letters of credence between two monarchs of equal rank will typically begin with the salutation "Sir My Brother" (or "Madame My Sister", in the case of a female monarch) and close with the valediction "Your Good Brother" (or "Sister", in the case of a female monarch). 24d30bfbf8

Union between Sweden and Norway Continuing differences between the two realms led to a failed attempt to create a separate Norwegian consular service and then, on 7 June 1905 Sweden and Norway or Sweden–Norway (Swedish: Svensk-norska unionen; Norwegian: Den svensk-norske union(en)), officially the United Kingdoms of Sweden and Norway, and known as the United Kingdoms, was a personal union of the separate kingdoms of Sweden and Norway under a common monarch and common foreign policy that lasted from 1814 until its peaceful dissolution in 1905. the union 24d30bfbf8

Quia maior Quia maior has since been recognised by historians as one of the most important medieval papal bulls on crusading. In it, Innocent presents crusading as a moral obligation for all Christians and lays out his plan to recapture Jerusalem and the rest of the Holy Land from the Muslims. Copies of the letter were sent to Ancona, Bohemia Quia maior is a papal bull issued by Pope Innocent III in April 1213. emphasis on the connection between salvation and military service to Christ is echoed in Quia maior. The longest of the three crusade-related letters that Innocent issued in the same month, it laid the foundation for the Fifth Crusade, which was formally approved by the Fourth Lateran Council in November 1215 24d30bfbf8

Formerly, residents of rural areas had to either travel to a distant post office to pick up their mail, or else pay for delivery by a private carrier. Free mail delivery began in American cities in 1863 with a limited scope. Shortly afterwards, rural citizens began petitioning for equal consideration. Postmaster General John Wanamaker first suggested rural free deliver (RFD) of mail in the United States in his annual report for fiscal year 1891. 24d30bfbf8 Rhodesia informed Britain of its intent to open a Lisbon mission headed by an accredited representative, independent from the British Embassy in the city, in June 1965. Whitehall refused to endorse the idea but Rhodesia continued nonetheless, and later that month appointed Harry Reedman to head the mission. The British government attempted unsuccessfully to block this unilateral act—Rhodesia's first—for some months afterwards. 24d30bfbf8

Commonly known as diplomatic credentials, the letter is addressed from one head of state to another, asking them to give "credence" (French: créance) to the ambassador's claim of speaking for their country 24d30bfbf8

Damaskinos of Athens After the 1941 German invasion of Greece and Archbishop Damaskinos Papandreou (Greek: Αρχιεπίσκοπος Δαμασκηνός Παπανδρέου), born Dimitrios Papandreou (Greek: Δημήτριος Παπανδρέου; 3 March 1891 – 20 May 1949), was the archbishop of Athens and All Greece from 1941 until his death in 1949. He was also the regent of Greece between the pull-out of the German occupation force in 1944 and the return of King George II to Greece in 1946. and forced the cancellation of his election and the appointment of Metropolitan Chrysanthus to the post. His rule was between the liberation of Greece from the Axis occupation of Greece during World War II and the Greek Civil War 24d30bfbf8

A draft version of the letter, titled Quoniam maior, is collected in the Chronicle of Burchard of Ursperg (compiled in 1229 or 1230). The final version of Quia maior was issued by Pope Innocent III between 19 and 29 April 1213, as part of his campaign to rally all Christians to join another crusade.
