HIV/AIDS stages of HIV infection: acute infection, clinical latency, and AIDS. Without treatment, it can lead to a spectrum of conditions including acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS). It can be managed with treatment and become a manageable chronic health condition. While there is no cure or vaccine for HIV, antiretroviral treatment can slow the course of the disease, and, if used before significant disease progression, can extend the life expectancy of someone living with HIV to a nearly standard level. It is a preventable disease. Early testing can show if treatment is needed to stop progression and to prevent infecting others. The initial period following infection with HIV is called acute HIV, primary HIV or acute The human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) is a retrovirus that attacks the immune system. Effective treatment for HIV-positive people (people living with HIV) involves a life-long regimen of medicine to suppress the virus, making the viral load undetectable. An HIV-positive person on treatment can expect to live a normal life, and die with the virus, not of it 6356364e15

During seroconversion, the antibody is present but not yet detectable. During infection or immunization, antigens enter the blood, and the immune system begins to produce antibodies in response. "What is the window period for HIV testing. After seroconversion, the antibody is detectable by standard techniques and remains detectable unless the individual seroreverts, in a phenomenon called seroreversion, or loss of antibody detectability, which can occur due to weakening of the immune system or decreasing antibody concentrations over time. Before seroconversion, the antigen itself may or may not be detectable, but the antibody is absent. Sexually transmitted infection Symptoms and signs of STIs may include vaginal discharge, penile discharge, ulcers on or around the genitals, and pelvic pain. treatment. STIs often do not initially cause symptoms, which results in a risk of transmitting them to others. Some STIs can cause infertility. The term sexually transmitted infection is generally preferred over sexually transmitted disease or venereal disease, as it includes cases with no symptomatic disease. There is often a window period after initial infection during which an STI test will be negative. During this period, the infection may be transmissible A sexually transmitted infection (STI), also known as a sexually transmitted disease (STD) or venereal disease (VD), is an infection that is spread by sexual activity, especially vaginal intercourse, anal sex, oral sex, or sometimes manual sex 6356364e15
