Nail (anatomy) It forms a seal that protects the nail bed A nail is a protective plate characteristically found at the tip of the digits (fingers and toes) of almost all primates (except for marmosets), homologous to the claws in other tetrapod animals. Fingernails and toenails are made of a tough rigid protein

Makeup can add color to the face, enhance features, or alter appearance to resemble a different person, creature, or object. Keratinocytes are the predominant cells of the epidermis, the outermost layer of the skin. Living keratinocytes reside in the basal, spinous, or granular layers of the epidermis. The outermost layer of the epidermis is called

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the stratum corneum and it is composed of terminally differentiated keratinocytes called the corneocytes. In the absence of disease, desquamation occurs when corneocytes are individually shed unnoticeably from the surface of the skin. Typically the time it takes for a corneocyte to be formed and then shed is about 14 weeks but this time can vary depending on the anatomical location that the skin is covering. For example, desquamation occurs more slowly at acral (palm and sole) surfaces and more rapidly where the skin is thin, such as the eyelids. Normal desquamation can be visualized by immersing skin in warm or hot water; inducing the outermost layer of corneocytes to shed (such as is the case after a hot shower or bath). 01107c1f49 Corneocytes are held together by corneodesmosomes... 01107c1f49

Mercury poisoning High-level exposure to methylmercury is known as Minamata disease. Glucose meter It is a key element of glucose testing, including home blood glucose monitoring (HBGM) performed by people with diabetes mellitus or hypoglycemia. The meter then displays the level in units of mg/dL or mmol/L.

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A small drop of blood, obtained from slightly piercing a fingertip with a lancet, is placed on a disposable test strip that the meter reads and uses to calculate the blood glucose level. Manufacturers recommend that this type of testing should only be used A glucose meter, also referred to as a "glucometer", is a medical device for determining the approximate concentration of glucose in the blood. – pricking the forearms or other less sensitive areas instead of the fingertips. It can also be a strip of glucose paper dipped into a substance and measured to the glucose chart 01107c1f49

The 19th century marked the emergence... 01107c1f49 Medically necessary dermatologic surgical procedures include curettage and electrosurgery, and Mohs surgery for the treatment of skin cancer, as well as skin grafting for repairing damaged skin. Cosmetic dermatologic surgeries comprise anti-ageing procedures, and mole and scar removal surgeries. The former include Botulinum toxin treatments and face lifts, while the latter include shave excision and dermabrasion. 01107c1f49 Sodium hydroxide is a highly corrosive base and alkali that decomposes lipids and proteins at ambient temperatures, and may cause severe chemical burns at high concentrations. It is highly soluble in water, and readily absorbs moisture

and carbon dioxide from the air. It forms a series of hydrates $\text{NaOH} \cdot n\text{H}_2\text{O}$. The monohydrate $\text{NaOH} \cdot \text{H}_2\text{O}$ crystallizes from water solutions between 12.3 and 61.8 °C. The commercially available "sodium hydroxide" is often this monohydrate, and published data may refer to it instead of the anhydrous compound. 01107c1f49

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
