Organic indigestion is the result of an underlying disease, such as gastritis, peptic ulcer disease (an ulcer of the stomach or duodenum), or cancer. Functional indigestion (previously called non-ulcer dyspepsia) is indigestion without evidence of underlying disease. Functional indigestion is estimated to affect about 15% of the general population in western countries and accounts for a majority of dyspepsia cases. 0022078c7f

Whole organism senescence involves an increase in death rates or a decrease in fecundity with increasing age, at least in the later part of an organism's life cycle. The 1934 discovery that calorie restriction can extend lifespans by 50% in rats, the existence of species having negligible senescence, and the existence of potentially immortal organisms such as members of the genus *Hydra* have motivated research into delaying senescence and thus age-related diseases. Parkinson's disease (PD) involves the gradual degeneration of dopamine producing neurons in a brain region called the substantia nigra and other related cell groups in the brainstem. This is accompanied by the accumulation of misfolded proteins such as alpha-synuclein. Alpha-synuclein is normally found in the presynaptic terminals of neurons. If alpha-synuclein is mis-folded and not cleared from cells by cellular degradation systems, it can build up to form clumps of proteins called Lewy bodies and Lewy neurites. Accumulation stimulates the release of pro-inflammatory molecules by the microglia, a protective response that can cause inflammation... 0022078c7f == Early life and career == 0022078c7f Gerson was born to a Jewish family in Wongrowitz, German Empire (Wągrowiec, now in Poland), on October 18, 1881. 0022078c7f Common causes include infection with *Helicobacter pylori* and excessive use of non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs). When unaccompanied by melena, hematemesis or a fall in hemoglobin with corresponding urea rises and creates an unstable reaction, and other causes of coffee ground vomitus need to be elucidated; for example, gastric stasis, bowel obstruction or ileus, that can cause oxidised food material to be vomited. ground vomitus. Environmental factors may affect aging – for example, overexposure to ultraviolet radiation accelerates skin aging. Coffee enemas “can cause colitis (inflammation of the Max Gerson (October 18, 1881 – March 8, 1959) was a German-born American physician who developed the Gerson therapy, a pseudoscientific dietary-based alternative cancer treatment that he falsely claimed could cure cancer and most chronic, degenerative diseases. Coffee enemas have contributed to the deaths of at least three people in the United States. Gerson therapy involves a plant-based diet with coffee enemas, ozone enemas, dietary supplements, and raw calf liver extract; the latter was discontinued in the 1980s after patients were hospitalized for bacterial infections

Indigestion Esophagitis is an inflammation of the esophagus, most commonly caused by gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD). Symptoms may include upper abdominal fullness, heartburn, nausea, belching, flatulence or upper abdominal pain. Indigestion is relatively common, affecting 20% of people at some point during their life, and is frequently caused by gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD) or gastritis. People may also experience feeling full earlier than expected when eating. little evidence to prove causation. It is Indigestion, also known as dyspepsia or upset stomach, is a condition of impaired digestion

Tooth polishing Tooth polishing has little therapeutic value and is usually done as a cosmetic procedure after debridement and before fluoride application. Common practice is to use a prophy cup—a small motorized rubber cup—along with an abrasive polishing compound. The purpose of polishing is to remove extrinsic stains, remove dental plaque accumulation, increase aesthetics and to reduce corrosion of metallic restorations. Particles within the prophylactic paste can go below the gumline and cause inflammation or delayed healing Tooth polishing procedures are done to smooth the surfaces of teeth and restorations. technique or prior inflammation of tissues

Peptic ulcer disease Diet does not play an important role in either causing or preventing ulcers Peptic ulcer disease refers to damage of the inner part of the stomach's gastric mucosa (lining of the stomach), the first part of the small intestine, or sometimes the lower esophagus. heart disease, and inflammation of the stomach lining or gallbladder inflammation. Complications may include bleeding, perforation, and blockage of the stomach. About a third of older people with peptic ulcers have no symptoms. The most common symptoms of a duodenal ulcer are waking at night with upper abdominal pain, and upper abdominal pain that improves with eating. With a gastric ulcer, the pain may worsen with eating. Other symptoms include belching, vomiting, weight loss, or poor appetite. The pain is often described as a burning or dull ache. Bleeding occurs in as many as 15% of cases. An ulcer in the stomach is called a gastric ulcer, while one in the first part of the intestines is a duodenal ulcer

Causes of Parkinson's disease PD's incidence and prevalence varies widely across geographic regions and shows spatial clustering, including higher rates in North America and Europe than in Asia and Africa. Worldwide, Parkinson's disease affects around 3% people over 65 years of age. microglia, a protective response that can cause inflammation and neuronal damage if it becomes chronic. Neuroinflammation causes the blood-brain barrier (BBB) Parkinson's disease (PD) is a neurodegenerative disorder that progresses over time, marked by bradykinesia (slowed movements), tremor (rhythmic shaking), and stiffness. As the condition worsens, patients may experience postural instability, finding it difficult to balance and maintain upright posture

Gerson described his approach in the book A Cancer Therapy: Results of 50 Cases (1958). The National Cancer Institute evaluated Gerson's claims and concluded that his data showed no benefit from his treatment. The therapy is both ineffective and dangerous. Serious illness and deaths have resulted from Gerson therapy. P. sylveirae belongs to the order Hymenoptera, which contains roughly 100,000 species of bees, ants, and wasps. The species belongs to the eusocial tribe Epiponini, which is characterized by complex nests, morphological differences between castes, and the occurrence of reproductive polygyny. P. sylveirae is the only species within its genus, and is most closely related to genera Polybia and Protopolybia. == Causes == Common causes include infection with Helicobacter pylori and use of nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs). Other causes include alcohol, smoking, cocaine, severe illness, autoimmune problems, radiation therapy and Crohn's disease. Endoscopy, a type of X-ray known as an upper gastrointestinal series, blood tests, and stool tests may help with diagnosis. Other conditions with similar symptoms include inflammation of the pancreas, gallbladder problems, and peptic ulcer disease.

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
