Myrmecophobia can cause people to experience anxiety, intrusive thoughts, sleeping problems, and avoidance. Other symptoms include sweating, increased heart rate, shortness of breaths, tumbling, panic, nausea, dry mouth, dizziness, headaches, and numbness.
