Opportunity cost As a representation of the relationship between scarcity and choice, the objective of opportunity cost is to ensure efficient use of scarce resources. Assuming the best choice is made, it is the "cost" incurred by not enjoying the benefit that would have been had if the second best available choice had been taken instead. In other words, explicit opportunity costs are the out-of-pocket costs of a firm, that are easily In microeconomic theory, the opportunity cost of a choice is the value of the best alternative forgone where, given limited resources, a choice needs to be made between several mutually exclusive alternatives.
