Shark Some sources extend the term "shark" as an informal category including extinct members of Chondrichthyes (cartilaginous fish) with a shark-like morphology, such as hybodonts. Modern sharks are classified within the division Selachii and are the sister group to the Batomorphi (rays and skates). Shark-like chondrichthyans such as Cladoseleache and Doliodus first appeared in the Devonian Period (419–359 million years), though some fossilized chondrichthyan-like scales are as old as the Late Ordovician (458–444 million years ago). Sharks are caught by humans for shark meat or shark fins.
