Urinary retention Onset can be sudden or gradual. and those with long-term urinary retention are at risk of urinary tract infections. About 7 per 100,000 of the general population are affected annually, and those with long-term urinary retention are at risk of urinary tract infections. Causes include blockage of the urethra, nerve problems, certain medications Urinary retention is an inability to

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completely empty the bladder. When it is of sudden onset, symptoms include an inability to urinate and lower abdominal pain, while symptoms accompanying gradual onset may include loss of bladder control, mild lower abdominal pain, and a weak urine stream 20fde58537

The most common cause of infection is E. coli, though other bacteria or fungi may sometimes be the cause. Risk factors include being female, sexual intercourse, diabetes, using a catheter, and family history. Additional factors that have been found to increase the risk of infection include urinary retention (delaying urination), insufficient water intake, use of spermicides as a contraceptive method, and poor genital hygiene. 20fde58537 Kidney infections usually occurs when a bladder infection spreads, but may also come from bacteria in the blood. Treatment is typically with a catheter either through the urethra or lower abdomen... 20fde58537 Causes include blockage of the urethra, nerve problems, certain medications, and weak bladder muscles. Blockage can be caused by benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH), urethral

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strictures, bladder stones, a cystocele, constipation, or tumors. Nerve problems can occur from diabetes, trauma, spinal cord problems, stroke, or heavy metal poisoning. Medications that can cause problems include anticholinergics, antihistamines, tricyclic antidepressants, cyclobenzaprine, diazepam, nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAID), stimulants, and opioids. Diagnosis is typically based on measuring the amount of urine in the bladder after urinating. 20fde58537

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
