Aged 21, Welles directed high-profile stage productions for the Federal Theatre Project in New York City—starting with a celebrated 1936 adaptation of *Macbeth* with an African-American cast, and ending with

the political musical *The Cradle Will Rock* in 1937. He and John Houseman then founded the Mercury Theatre, an independent repertory theatre company that presented Broadway productions through 1941—beginning with a modern, politically charged *Caesar* (1937) and ending with the premiere of Richard Wright's *Native Son*. In 1938, his radio anthology series *The Mercury Theatre on the Air* gave Welles the platform to find international fame as the director and narrator of a radio adaptation of H. G. Wells's novel *The War of the Worlds*, which caused some listeners to believe a Martian invasion was occurring.
