Bellhop The bellhop traditionally is a boy or adolescent male, hence the term bellboy. Bellhops interact with a variety of people each day, and duties often include opening the front door, moving luggage, valeting cars, calling cabs, transporting guests, advising directions, performing basic concierge work, and responding to guests' needs. While carrying luggage, they escort guests to their rooms.

Sealing Originally, sports coats were worn as appropriate attire for participating in certain outdoor sports. With time, they were adopted by those attending such events, and came to be used on more formal occasions, sometimes being used in school uniforms.

Anorak The word anorak comes from the Greenlandic (Kalaallisut) word annoraaq. It did not appear in English until 1924; an early definition is "a beaded item worn by Greenland women or brides in the 1930s". In the early 1950s it was made from nylon, but changed to poplin by 1959, when it was featured...

Ragged-jacket At this young age, the pups are not yet capable of swimming. It does not feed during this time and therefore loses weight.

Sealing "ragged jacket". The pup stays on the ice for about two weeks before the fur has moulted. four weeks of age, the seal is called a "beater". The moulting begins when the pup is at an age of about 12-14 days, at which time they cease nursing.

Ragged jacket Definition & Meaning - A ragged-jacket (or, occasionally, "raggedy-jacket") is the name given to a harp or grey seal pup when it is undergoing its first moult, and the intermediate stage between a "whitecoat" and a "beater". When the white fur has been completely shed at around four weeks of age, the seal is called a "beater".

Parka Some Inuit anoraks require regular coating with fish oil to retain their water resistance. Parkas are typically longer, often extending to the thighs or knees. Parkas and anoraks are staples of Inuit clothing, traditionally made from caribou or seal skin, for hunting and kayaking in the frigid Arctic.
