These are usually followed by vomiting, diarrhoea, rash, hepatic and renal dysfunction, at which point some people begin to bleed both internally and externally. Symptoms typically start anywhere between two days and three weeks after infection. Death is often due to shock from fluid loss, and typically occurs between 6 and 16 days after the first symptoms appear. In cities, it is spread primarily by *Aedes aegypti*, a type of mosquito found throughout the tropics and subtropics. The virus is an RNA virus of the genus *Orthoflavivirus* (full scientific name *Orthoflavivirus flavi*). The disease may be difficult to tell apart from other illnesses, especially in the early stages. To confirm a suspected case, blood-sample testing with a polymerase chain reaction is required. 3c7eeef53b

The vast majority of them died of yellow fever, making the epidemic in the city of 50,000 people, one of the most severe in United States history. By the end of September, 20,000 people had fled the city, including congressional and executive officials of the federal government of the United States. Most did not return until after the epidemic had abated in late November. The mortality rate peaked in October before frost finally killed the mosquitoes and brought an end to the outbreak. The Philadelphia 1793 yellow fever epidemic was an epidemic that took place in Philadelphia. Doctors tried a variety of treatments but knew neither the origin of the fever nor that the disease was transmitted by mosquitoes (this information was not verified until the late 19th century). Travellers who wish to enter certain countries or territories must be vaccinated against yellow fever ten days before Vaccination requirements for international travel are the aspect of vaccination policy that concerns the movement of people across borders. provision for smallpox vaccination. At border checks, these travellers are required to show proof of vaccination against specific diseases; the most widely used vaccination record is the International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis (ICVP or Carte Jaune/Yellow Card) 3c7eeef53b

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
