Six forces model The model provides a framework of six key forces that should be considered when defining corporate strategy to determine the overall attractiveness of an industry. The sixth force was proposed in the mid-1990s. of the Porter's five forces model proposed by Michael Porter in his 1979 article published in the Harvard Business Review "How Competitive Forces Shape The six forces model is an analysis model used to give a holistic assessment of any given industry and identify the structural underlining drivers of profitability and competition. Porter's five forces analysis An "unattractive" industry is one in which these forces collectively limit the potential for above-normal profits. It is rooted in industrial organization economics and Porter's Five Forces Framework is a method of analysing the competitive environment of a business. It is rooted in industrial organization economics

and identifies five forces that determine the competitive intensity and, consequently, the attractiveness or unattractiveness of an industry with respect to its profitability. Porter's Five Forces Framework is a method of analysing the competitive environment of a business. The most unattractive industry structure would approach that of pure competition, in which available profits for all firms are reduced to normal profit levels

Porter said in an interview... Porter refers to these forces as the microenvironment, to contrast it with the more general term macroenvironment. They consist of those forces close to a company that affects its ability to serve its customers and make a profit. A change in any of the forces normally requires a business unit to re-assess the marketplace given the overall change in industry information. The overall industry attractiveness does not imply...

He is generally regarded as the father of the modern strategy field. He was one of the founders of the consulting firm The Monitor Group (now part of Deloitte) and FSG, a social impact consultancy. His work has been recognized by governments, non-governmental organizations and universities
