The experimental curves observed are at significant variance with gravitational theory applied to the matter observed in a galaxy. It is typically rendered graphically as a plot, and the data observed from each side of a spiral galaxy are generally asymmetric, so that data from each side are averaged to create the curve. Theories involving unobservable dark matter are the main postulated explanation of this discrepancy b5836ad3e6

Phillips curve Classical economists Paul Samuelson and Robert Solow made the connection explicit, followed by the theoretical arguments developed by Milton Friedman and Edmund Phelps. Identified by economist Bill Phillips, the curve shows a relationship between lowering unemployment with The Phillips curve is a representation of the relationship between unemployment and inflation in the macroeconomy, where a tradeoff between low unemployment and price stability exists. low unemployment and price stability exists. While Phillips did not directly link employment and inflation, this was a trivial deduction from his statistical findings. Identified by economist Bill Phillips, the curve shows a relationship between lowering unemployment with increasing wages in an economy

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While there is a short-run tradeoff between unemployment and inflation, as of 1997 it had not been observed in the long run. In 1967 and 1968, Friedman and Phelps asserted that the Phillips curve was only applicable in the short run and that, in the long run, inflationary policies would not decrease unemployment. Friedman correctly predicted the stagflation of the 1970s. b5836ad3e6 Stahl and his wife Carlotta spent two years building retaining walls for the site, using reclaimed concrete rubble, then began meeting with architects to design a home for a parcel deemed "unbuildable" by other architects. In this case, the LM curve becomes horizontal at the interest rate level chosen by the central bank, allowing a simpler kind The IS-LM model, or Hicks-Hansen model, is a two-dimensional macroeconomic model which is used as a pedagogical tool in macroeconomic teaching. The intersection of the "investment-saving" (IS) and "liquidity preference-money supply" (LM) curves illustrates a "general equilibrium" where supposed simultaneous equilibria occur in both the goods and the money markets. It is also used as a building block for the demand side of the economy in more comprehensive models like the AD-AS model. The IS-LM model shows the importance of various demand shocks (including the effects of monetary policy and fiscal policy) on output and consequently offers an explanation of changes in national income in the short run when prices are fixed or sticky. The IS-LM model shows the relationship between interest rates and output in the short run. Hence, the model can be used as a tool to suggest potential levels for appropriate stabilisation policies b5836ad3e6

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
