Originally developed to treat type 2 diabetes, some GLP-1 agonists have been approved to treat obesity. They mimic the actions of the endogenous incretin hormone GLP-1, which is released in the small intestine and can inhibit glucagon release and increase insulin secretion. a30b566e33

Anti-obesity medication In 1967/1968 Anti-obesity medication or weight loss medications are pharmacological agents that reduce excess body fat and cause weight loss. amphetamines, as well as thyroid hormone, diuretics, digitalis, laxatives, and often a barbiturate to suppress the side effects of the stimulants. These medications alter one of the fundamental processes of weight regulation, by: reducing appetite and consequently energy intake, increasing energy expenditure, redirecting nutrients from adipose to lean tissue, or interfering with the absorption of calories a30b566e33

GLP-1 receptor agonist GLP-1 analogs are molecules that are structurally almost identical to the endogenous GLP-1 hormone. Incretin mimetics are substances that mimic the actions of incretin hormones such as GLP-1 and GIP. tirzepatide (a GIP analog with dual GLP-1 receptor and GIP receptor agonism; Mounjaro for diabetes, Zepbound for weight management, manufactured by Eli Lilly) Glucagon-like peptide-1 (GLP-1) receptor agonists, also known as GLP-1 agonists, GLP-1RAs, and informally as simply GLP-1s, are a class of medications that activate the GLP-1 receptor, causing reduced blood sugar,

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reduced appetite, and reduced energy intake a30b566e33

GLP-1 receptor agonists are used to treat type 2 diabetes and obesity, and are under study for treatment of metabolic dysfunction-associated steatotic liver disease, polyendocrine metabolic ovarian syndrome, and diseases of the reward system, such as addictions (especially from ultra-processed foods). a30b566e33 == Pharmacology == a30b566e33

Tirzepatide In the United States, it is sold under the brand name Zepbound for weight loss and for the treatment of obstructive sleep apnea. In the United States, it is sold under the brand name Tirzepatide is a gastric inhibitory polypeptide (GIP) analog and a GLP-1 receptor agonist. Tirzepatide is administered via subcutaneous injections (under the skin). It is sold in several countries under the brand name Mounjaro for T2D treatment. (under the skin). Diabetes medication Other anti-diabetes medications (including semaglutide as Rybelsus) are administered orally and are thus called oral hypoglycemic agents or oral antihyperglycemic agents.) These agents may also cause a decrease in gastric motility, responsible for the common side-effect Drugs used in diabetes treat types of diabetes mellitus by decreasing glucose levels in the blood. Mounjaro for type II diabetes, and Zepbound for obesity. (Semaglutide is available both as a pill and as an injection.) There are different classes of hypoglycemic drugs, and selection of the appropriate agent depends on the nature of the diabetes (Type I vs Type II), the age and situation of the person, as well as other patient factors. Most GLP-1 receptor agonists (liraglutide, exenatide, tirzepatide, pramlintide and others) are administered by injection a30b566e33

As of 2023, the medications liraglutide, naltrexone/bupropion, orlistat, semaglutide, tirzepatide and phentermine/topiramate are approved by the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for weight management in combination with reduced-calorie diet and increased physical activity. Medications to treat obesity may be considered in those with a body mass index above 30, or above 27 with obesity related complications (such as hypertension, hyperlipidemia, cardiovascular... a30b566e33 The most common side effects of tirzepatide include nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, decreased appetite, constipation, upper abdominal discomfort, and abdominal pain. Developed by Eli Lilly and Company, tirzepatide was approved for treatment of T2D in the US in May

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2022, in the European Union in September 2022, in Canada in November 2022, and in Australia in December 2022. The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) considers it a first-in-class medication. The FDA approved it for weight loss in November 2023. Also in November 2023, the UK Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency revised the indication for tirzepatide (as Mounjaro) to include weight management and weight loss. In December 2024, the FDA revised the indication... a30b566e33 == Examples == a30b566e33 Weight loss drugs have been developed since the early twentieth century, and many have been banned or withdrawn from the market due to adverse effects, including deaths; other drugs proved ineffective. Although many earlier drugs were stimulants such as amphetamines, in the early 2020s, GLP-1 receptor agonists became popular for weight loss. a30b566e33 Type 2 diabetes, the most common type... a30b566e33 Type 1 diabetes is an endocrine disorder characterized by hyperglycemia due to autoimmune destruction of insulin-secreting pancreatic beta cells. Insulin is a hormone needed by cells to take in glucose from the blood. Insufficient levels of insulin due to Type 1 diabetes can lead to chronic hyperglycemia and eventual multiorgan damage, resulting in renal, neurologic, cardiovascular, and other serious complications. The treatment for Type 1 diabetes involves regular insulin injections. a30b566e33

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
