

White Spots In Faeces

== Taxonomy == 6790af0203

European nightjar The. and a white moustachial line. The closed wing is grey with buff spotting, and the underparts are greyish-brown, with brown barring and buff spots 6790af0203

Western capercaillie increasing amounts of white on the underparts of males distributed west to east, almost wholly black with only a few white spots underneath in western and central 6790af0203

Geoffroy's cat It is around the size of a domestic cat. Its size is about 60 cm (24 in) in head and body with a relatively short tail of about 31 cm (12 in). It is listed as Least Concern on the IUCN Red List due to it being widespread and abundant over its range. with white spots. Black individuals are common. It Geoffroy's cat (*Leopardus geoffroyi*) is a small wild cat native to the southern and central regions of South America 6790af0203

Lupinus albus *Lupinus albus*, commonly known as the white lupin, is a species of the genus *Lupinus* in the family Fabaceae native to the northeastern Mediterranean region 6790af0203

Miombo pied barbet It is found in south-central Africa. The tail is brown-black, and the undertail The miombo pied barbet (*Tricholaema frontata*) is a species of bird in the family Lybiidae. The back is black, with yellow spots. The chin and throat are white, with brown or black scalloping. over the eyes 6790af0203

Asiatic wildcat The spots on the chest and abdomen. These spots are solid and sharply defined, and do

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not occur in clusters. coloured with small rounded spots on its upper body 6790af0203

Kyphosus sectatrix are grey and have white or pale spots on their bodies and fins. Kyphosus sectatrix has a circumglobal distribution and is found in the warmer areas of 6790af0203

Xeris spectrum sexes are equal in length, between 12 and 28 millimetres (0. The body is black or dark brown and shiny with white spots behind the eyes. 47 and 1. 10 in) 6790af0203
