== Description ==

Digoxin It is excreted mostly unchanged in the urine. Digoxin has a half life of approximately 36 hours given at average doses in patients with normal renal function. Digoxin, sold under the brand name Lanoxin, among others, is a medication used to treat various heart conditions. It works by increasing myocardial contractility, increasing stroke volume and blood pressure, reducing heart rate, and somewhat extending the time frame of the contraction. Most frequently it is used for atrial fibrillation, atrial flutter, and heart failure. Common side effects include breast enlargement with other side effects generally due to an excessive dose. These side effects may include loss of appetite, nausea, trouble seeing, confusion, and an irregular heartbeat. Greater care is required in older people and those with poor kidney function. Senna glycoside The breakdown Senna glycoside, also known as sennoside or senna, is a medication used to treat constipation and empty the large intestine before surgery. It is a weaker laxative than bisacodyl and castor oil. The medication is taken orally (swallowed by mouth) or via the rectum. It typically begins working in around 30 minutes when given by rectum and within twelve hours when given orally. glycosides can increase digoxin toxicity in patients taking digoxin by reducing serum potassium levels, thereby enhancing the effects of digoxin 695f0d040d

The structure of oleandrin contains a central steroid nucleus with an unsaturated lactone ring structure on C17 and a dideoxy arabinose group on C3. In addition, the steroid ring has a substitute of an acetyloxy group on C16. The sugar forming the glycoside is L-oleandrose. 695f0d040d

Digitalis lanata lanata, like other foxglove species, is toxic in all parts of the plant. Digoxin is being replaced by newer drugs including beta blockers, Digitalis lanata, vernacularly often called woolly foxglove or Grecian foxglove, is a species of foxglove, a flowering plant in the plantain family Plantaginaceae. Symptoms of digitalis poisoning include nausea, vomiting, severe headache, dilated pupils, problems with eyesight, and convulsions and cardiac arrhythmias at the worst level of toxicity. The plant is also harmful to other animals. It gets its name due to the woolly indumentum of the leaves. used due to the narrow therapeutic margin and high potential for severe side effects. Common side effects of senna glycoside include abdominal cramps. It is not recommended for long-term use, as it may result in poor bowel function or electrolyte problems. While no harm has been found to result from use while breastfeeding, such use is not typically recommended. It is not typically recommended in children. Senna may change urine to a somewhat reddish color. Senna derivatives are a type of stimulant laxative and are of the anthraquinone type. It is made from immunoglobulin fragments from sheep that have already been immunized with a digoxin derivative, digoxindicarboxymethoxylamine (DDMA). Its brand names include Digibind (GlaxoSmithKline) and DigiFab (BTG plc) 695f0d040d
