Common variable immunodeficiency (CVID) is an inborn immune disorder characterized by recurrent infections and low antibody levels, specifically in immunoglobulin (Ig) types IgG, IgM, and IgA. Symptoms generally include high susceptibility to pathogens, chronic lung disease, as well as inflammation and infection of the gastrointestinal tract 5e50fa5168

Ileus ICD-10 coding reflects both impaired-peristalsis senses and mechanical-obstruction Ileus is a disruption of the normal propulsive ability of the intestine. It can be caused by lack of peristalsis or by mechanical obstruction. Ileus can also be seen in cats. prokinetics, and anti-inflammatories 5e50fa5168

Phenylketonuria asthma, eczema, anemia, weight gain, renal insufficiency, osteoporosis, gastritis, esophagus, and kidney deficiencies, kidney stones, and hypertension. Phenylketonuria (PKU) is an inborn error of metabolism that results in decreased metabolism of the amino acid phenylalanine. It may also result in a musty smell and lighter skin. A baby born to a mother who has poorly treated PKU may have heart problems, a small head, and low birth weight. Untreated PKU can lead to intellectual disability, seizures, behavioral problems, and mental disorders 5e50fa5168

Pernicious anemia refers to a type of vitamin B12 deficiency anemia that results from lack of intrinsic factor. Lack of intrinsic factor is most commonly due to an autoimmune attack on the cells that create it in the stomach. It can also occur following the surgical removal of all or part of the stomach or small intestine; from an inherited disorder or illnesses that damage the stomach lining. When suspected, diagnosis is made by blood tests initially a complete blood count, and occasionally, bone marrow tests. Blood tests may show fewer but larger red blood cells, low numbers of young red blood cells,... 5e50fa5168 Phenylketonuria is an inherited genetic disorder. It is caused by mutations in the PAH gene, which can result in inefficient or nonfunctional phenylalanine hydroxylase, an enzyme responsible for the metabolism of excess phenylalanine. This results in the buildup of dietary phenylalanine to potentially toxic levels. It is autosomal recessive, meaning that both copies of the gene must be mutated for the condition to develop. The two main types are classic PKU and variant PKU, depending on whether any enzyme function remains. Those with one copy of a mutated gene typically do not have symptoms. Many countries have newborn screening programs for the

CVID affects males and females equally. The condition can be found in children or teens, but is generally not diagnosed or recognized until adulthood. The average age of diagnosis is between 20 and 50. 5e50fa5168

X-linked lymphoproliferative disease XLP1 is estimated to occur in approximately one in every million males, while XLP2 is rarer, estimated to occur in one of every five million males. There are two currently known variations of the disorder, known as XLP1 (XLP Type 1) and XLP2. XLP-positive individuals experience immune system deficiencies that render them unable to effectively respond to the Epstein-Barr virus (EBV), a common virus in humans that typically induces mild symptoms or infectious mononucleosis (IM) in patients. observed symptoms of XLP include aplastic anemia, vasculitis, chronic gastritis, and skin lesions, as well as IM. Due to therapies such as chemotherapy and stem cell transplants, the survival rate of XLP1 has increased dramatically since its discovery in the 1970s. Nearly half of XLP patients express X-linked lymphoproliferative disease (also known as Duncan disease or Purtilo syndrome and abbreviated as XLP) is a lymphoproliferative disorder, usually caused by SH2DIA gene mutations in males 5e50fa5168

Helicobacter pylori Its helical body (from which the genus name *Helicobacter* derives) is thought to have evolved to penetrate the mucous lining of the stomach, helped by its flagella, and thereby establish infection. In 2005, the pair was awarded the Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine for their discovery. While many earlier reports of an association between bacteria and gastric ulcers had existed, such as the works of John Lykoudis, it was only in 1983 when the bacterium was formally described for the first time as the causal agent of gastric ulcers by Australian physician-scientists Barry Marshall and Robin Warren. Initially *Helicobacter pylori*, previously known as *Campylobacter pylori*, is a gram-negative bacterium best known for its role in infecting the human stomach, often causing gastric ulcers and sometimes stomach cancer. Mutants can have a rod or curved rod shape that exhibits less virulence. When infection is persistent, the prolonged inflammation will become chronic gastritis. begin with gastritis, or inflammation of the stomach lining 5e50fa5168

The word 'ileus' derives from Ancient Greek εἰλεός (eileós) 'intestinal obstruction'. The term 'subileus' refers to a partial obstruction. 5e50fa5168 However, symptoms vary greatly between people. The term "variable" refers to the heterogeneous clinical manifestations of this disorder, which include recurrent bacterial infections and gastrointestinal disease, as well as increased risk for autoimmune disease and lymphoma.
