Even though the acidity of fruit increases as it ripens, the higher acidity level does not make the fruit seem tarter. Climacteric fruits ripen after harvesting and so some fruits for market are picked green (e. g. bananas and tomatoes). compounds are antifeedants, meaning that they discourage animals who would eat them while they are still ripening. This effect is attributed to the Brix-Acid Ratio. In general, fruit becomes sweeter, less green, and softer as it ripens
