Bhismaknagar The discovery of kaolin pottery at Bhismaknagar has been interpreted as evidence of early cultural contact. noted that the bricks were large, thick and nearly square, without visible marks or ornamentation. It formed part of the historical Sadhayapura capital region of the Chutia kingdom and can be identified with the fortified hill city of Doi-Thang described in the Buranjis. Excavations have yielded roof tiles and decorative finials, providing evidence for the use of tiled roofing in at least some structures within the fortified settlement. The original fort may have been associated with the line of hill-foot forts attributed to the Chutia king Gaurinarayan. It is located east of Roing in Lower Dibang Valley district. According to the Chutia chronicles, Gaurinarayan, after consolidating his kingdom, "built a line of forts along the foot of the hills", along with large tanks and temples. Doi-Thang (also known as Thanggiri), was one of the three fortified cities mentioned in the Buranjis, the others being Barnagar (Che-lung in Tai) and Chandangiri (Doi-Chantan). Formal excavations at Bhismaknagar were undertaken Bhismaknagar is an archeological site in Indian state of Arunachal Pradesh.
