In contrast, controllable renewable energy sources include dammed hydroelectricity, bioenergy, or geothermal power. Renewable energy is often deployed together with further electrification. energy sources pollute much less than fossil fuels. Renewable energy installations can be large or small and are suited for both urban and rural areas. Variable renewable energy sources are those that have a fluctuating nature, such as wind power and solar power. Bioenergy and geothermal power are also significant in some countries. This has several benefits: electricity can move heat and vehicles efficiently and is clean at the point of consumption. Renewables also cause much less air pollution than fossil fuels, improving public

Many countries are shutting down coal-fired power stations, and fossil-fuelled electricity generation was thought to have peaked in 2022, whereas the data indicates that electrical energy generated by fossil fuel is still increasing as of 2024. Hence electricity generation is still not moving off coal fast enough to meet climate goals. Fossil fuel divestment campaigns emerged on college and university campuses in the United States in 2011 with students urging their administrations to turn endowment investments in the fossil fuel industry into investments in clean energy and communities most impacted by climate change. In 2012, Unity College in Maine became the first institution of higher learning to divest its endowment from fossil fuels. While fossil fuel divestment focusses on financial asset management, a related movement, Fossil Free Research, campaigns for universities to stop accepting research funding and sponsorships from fossil

Since then, the fossil fuel industry has actively denied and cast doubt on climate science, confused the public and politicians, and prevented climate and clean energy policies through disinformation, lobbying, and propaganda and continues to do so, for example by falsely claiming there is no climate consensus among scientists.

sources in sectors such as transport and heating. Alternatives to fossil fuels include electrification, green hydrogen and biofuel. Phase-out policies include both demand-side and supply-side measures. Whereas demand-side approaches seek to reduce fossil-fuel consumption, supply-side initiatives seek to constrain production to accelerate the pace of energy transition... 0356adf2d7 For an energy to be renewable, it must be an endless source. Nuclear power is therefore not considered renewable, due to its reliance on non-renewable fuel. 0356adf2d7

In 2023, 77% of primary energy consumption in the A fossil fuel is a flammable carbon compound- or hydrocarbon-containing material formed naturally in the Earth's crust from the buried remains of prehistoric organisms (animals, plants or microplanktons), a process that occurs within geological formations. Reservoirs of such compound mixtures, such as coal, petroleum and natural gas, can be extracted and burnt as fuel for human consumption to provide energy for direct use (such as for cooking, heating or lighting), to power heat engines (such as steam or internal combustion engines) that can propel vehicles, or to generate electricity via steam turbine generators. to the length of time it takes for them to form, fossil fuels are considered non-renewable resources 0356adf2d7

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
