"Country USA" was first issued during the summer of 1988, and is patterned after Time-Life's successful "Rock'n'Roll Era" and "Your Hit Parade" series. It represented Time-Life's first real attempt at chronicling country music's post-1950 history; earlier in the 1980s, Time-Life had a budget "Country Series" and the later "Country & Western Classics." He followed this in 1988 with *Libra*, a novel about the assassination of John F. Kennedy. DeLillo won the PEN/Faulkner Award for *Mao II*, about terrorism and the media's scrutiny of writers' private lives, and the William Dean Howells Medal for *Underworld*, a historical novel that ranges in time from the dawn of the Cold War to the birth of the Internet. He was awarded the 1999 Jerusalem Prize, the 2010 PEN/Saul Bellow Award for Achievement in American Fiction, and the 2013 Library of Congress Prize for American Fiction. He began his career as a tap dancer, vaudeville performer, and master of ceremonies in the 1930s. He later worked as a disc jockey on radio station WDIA in Memphis, both before and after his recordings became successful. He remained active into the 1990s and

He was the father of the singers Carla Thomas (with whom he recorded duets) and Vaneese Thomas and the keyboard player...
