Spermatocele They are not cancerous, nor do they cause an increased risk of testicular cancer. Small spermatoceles are relatively common, occurring in an estimated 30 percent of males. Spermatoceles are typically filled with spermatozoa and they can vary in size from several millimeters to many centimeters. Additionally, unlike varicoceles, they do not reduce fertility. Men with history of vasectomy are also

predisposed to chronic noninfectious epididymitis. The fluid is usually a clear or milky white color and may contain sperm. inflammation that leads to swelling and ductal obstruction. Azoospermia in these patients could be a result of Y chromosome microdeletions, cancer of the testicles or damage to the

Sperm granuloma Sperm granulomas can appear as a result of surgery (such as a vasectomy), trauma, or an infection (such as sexually transmitted diseases). They can appear as early as four days after surgery and fully formed ones can appear as late as 208 days later. While the majority of sperm granulomas are present along the vas deferens, the rest of them form at the

epididymis. Sperm granulomas may also have a yellow, white, or cream colored center when cut open. "Spermatocele" is originally derived from the Greek term spermatos (sperm) and kele (cavity or mass). Oftentimes, "epididymal cyst" has been used interchangeably with "spermatocele." Epididymal cysts may appear anywhere along or within the epididymis and do not contain sperm, whereas spermatoceles may contain sperm.

Vasectomy reversal The procedures remain technically demanding and may not restore the pre-vasectomy condition. Although vasectomy is considered a permanent form of contraception, advances in microsurgery have improved the success of vasectomy reversal procedures. Two procedures

Vasectomy reversal is a term used for surgical procedures that reconnect the male reproductive tract after interruption by a vasectomy. Two procedures are possible at the time of vasectomy reversal:

- vasovasostomy (vas deferens to vas deferens connection) and
- vasepididymostomy (epididymis to vas deferens connection).

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These new methods include topical creams, daily pills, injections, long-acting implants, and external devices, with both hormonal and non-hormonal mechanisms of action. Some could even be unisex, or usable by any person, because they could theoretically

incapacitate mature sperm in the man's body before ejaculation, or incapacitate sperm in the body of a woman after insemination.

Vasectomy is an elective surgical procedure that results in male sterilization, often as a means of permanent contraception. During the procedure, the vasa deferentia are cut and tied or sealed so as to prevent sperm from entering into the urethra and thereby prevent fertilization of ova through sexual intercourse. Hospitalization is not normally required as the procedure is not complicated, the incisions are small, and the necessary equipment routine. e.
