Various taxonomic families of land slugs form part of several quite different evolutionary lineages, which also include snails. Thus, the various families of slugs are not closely related, despite the superficial similarity in overall body form. There are two forms, distinguished by leaf type. In both forms, the leaves are arranged in dense whorls around the base of the stem. Some distinguishing characteristics of the T. melophagium species is the placement of the kinetoplast being closer to the nucleus rather than to the posterior end and a pointed tail. This helps to differentiate T. melophagium from other Trypanosoma species such as T. cruzi, T. lewisi, T. rangeli and more. Land snails are a polyphyletic group comprising at least ten independent evolutionary transitions to terrestrial life (the last common ancestor of all gastropods was marine). The majority of land snails are pulmonates that have a lung and breathe air. Most of the non-pulmonate land snails belong to lineages in the Caenogastropoda, and tend to have a gill and an operculum. The largest clade of non-pulmonate land snails is the Cyclophoroidea, with more than 7,000 species. Many of these operculate land snails live in habitats or microhabitats that are sometimes (or often) damp or wet, such as in moss.
