Infectious bursal disease The disease is easily spread from infected chickens to healthy chickens through food, water, and physical contact. Acute disease and death is due to the necrotizing Infectious bursal disease (IBD), also known as Gumboro disease, infectious bursitis, and infectious avian nephrosis, is a highly contagious disease of young chickens and turkeys caused by infectious bursal disease virus (IBDV), characterized by immunosuppression and mortality generally at 3 to 6 weeks of age. In recent years, very virulent strains of IBDV (vvIBDV), causing severe mortality in chicken, have emerged in Europe, Latin America, South-East Asia, Africa, and the Middle East. (gut-associated lymphoid tissue), CALT (conjunctiva), BALT (Bronchial) caecal tonsils, Harderian gland, etc. Infection is via the oro-fecal route, with affected birds excreting high levels of the virus for approximately 2 weeks after infection. It is economically important to the poultry industry worldwide due to increased susceptibility to other diseases and negative interference with effective vaccination. The disease was first discovered in Gumboro, Delaware in 1962 fc506bb5fb

Polio A less common symptom is permanent paralysis, and possible death in extreme cases. These symptoms usually pass within one or two weeks. Approximately 75% of cases are asymptomatic; mild symptoms which can occur include sore throat and fever; in a proportion of cases more severe symptoms develop such as headache, neck stiffness, and paresthesia. Years after recovery, post-polio syndrome may occur, with a slow development of muscle weakness similar to what the person had during the initial infection. immune individuals, IgA antibodies against poliovirus are present in the tonsils and gastrointestinal tract and able to block virus replication; IgG and Poliomyelitis (POH-lee-oh-MY-ə-LY-tiss), commonly shortened to polio, is a vaccine-preventable infectious disease caused by the poliovirus fc506bb5fb

== Early life == fc506bb5fb BFL is diagnosed based on symptoms, and how these get worse on exposure to avian proteins. Radiology can show damage to the lungs, which has a characteristic "ground glass" appearance. Bronchoscopy shows chronic inflammation, with biopsies showing lymphocytosis and granulomatous tissue. BFL may be treated with steroids such as prednisone to reduce inflammation, and removal of exposure to avian proteins. If pulmonary fibrosis has not occurred, treatments tend to be very effective. fc506bb5fb While generally safe, complications may include bleeding, vomiting, dehydration, trouble eating, and trouble talking. Throat pain typically lasts about one to two weeks after surgery. Bleeding occurs in about 1% within the first day and another 2% after that. Coma Comas can be the result of natural causes, or can be medically induced; for example, during general anesthesia. People in a coma often require extensive medical care to maintain their health and prevent complications such as pneumonia or blood clots. Coma patients exhibit a complete absence of wakefulness and are unable to consciously feel, speak or move. predictor of a chance of recovery. The person may experience respiratory and circulatory problems due to the body's inability to maintain normal bodily functions. For example, after four months of coma caused by brain damage, the chance of partial recovery is less than 15%, and the A coma (from Ancient Greek κῶμα koma 'deep sleep') is a prolonged state of deep unconsciousness in which a person cannot be awakened, fails to respond normally to stimuli (including pain, light, and sound), lacks a normal sleep-wake cycle and does not initiate voluntary actions fc506bb5fb

Pleurisy can be caused by a variety of conditions, including viral or bacterial infections, autoimmune disorders, and pulmonary embolism. The most common cause is a viral infection. Other causes include bacterial infection, pneumonia, pulmonary embolism, autoimmune disorders, lung cancer, following heart surgery, pancreatitis and asbestosis. Occasionally the cause remains unknown. The underlying mechanism involves the rubbing together of the pleurae instead of smooth gliding. Other conditions that can produce similar symptoms include pericarditis, heart attack, cholecystitis, pulmonary embolism, and pneumothorax. Diagnostic testing may include a chest X-ray, electrocardiogram (ECG), and blood tests. fc506bb5fb

Prophylactic tonsillectomy is the removal of part or all of the tonsils as a prophylactic measure against future oropharyngeal carcinomas. This is a life-saving procedure for those at high risk of developing cancer in certain organs. bowel. Pleurisy The procedure to remove fluid in the chest is called a diagnostic thoracentesis. It is highly infectious, and is spread from person to person either through fecal-oral transmission (e.g. poor hygiene, or by ingestion of food or water contaminated by human feces), or via the oral-oral route. Those who are infected may spread the disease for up to six weeks even if no symptoms are present. The disease may be diagnosed by finding the virus in the feces or detecting antibodies against it in the blood.
