FCSRCA is the primary consumer protection regulation for in-vitro fertilization in the US. Though participation in FCSRCA is mandatory, there is no penalty for non-participation. In 2024, approximately 90% of fertility clinics participated, though the results are susceptible to manipulation by cherry picking couples with a higher chance of conception. The CDC annually audits a sampling of participating clinics for validity. However, the steps to be followed before and after insemination are the same. In terms of insemination, ICSI needs only one sperm cell per oocyte, while IVF needs 50,000–100,000. This is because the acrosome reaction has to take place and thousands of sperm cells have to be involved in IVF.
