Historically, Baltimore had at least two districts that were called "Chinatown" where the first one existed on the 200 block of Marion Street during the 1880s. A night market in September 2018 marked the first Asian celebration of the area. The initial Chinese population came because of the transcontinental railroad, however, the Chinese population never exceeded 400 as of 1941. Chinatown was largely gone by the First World War due to urban renewal.
