Fiscal policy The combination of these policies enables these authorities to target inflation and to increase employment. The use of government revenue expenditures to influence macroeconomic variables developed in reaction to the Great Depression of the 1930s, when the previous laissez-faire approach to economic management became unworkable. In modern economies, inflation is conventionally considered "healthy" in the range of 2%-3%. Additionally, it is designed to try to keep GDP growth at 2%-3% and the unemployment rate near the natural unemployment rate of 4%-5%. There are two general types of implementation problems: the economic problem of producing and allocating public and private goods and choosing over a finite set of alternatives.
