The Skin of Our Teeth Skin of Our Teeth is a play by Thornton Wilder that won the Pulitzer Prize for Drama. It opened on October 15, 1942, at the Shubert Theatre in New Haven, Connecticut, before moving to the Plymouth Theatre on Broadway on November 18, 1942. The play is a three-part allegory about the life of mankind, centering on the Antrobus family of the fictional town of Excelsior, New Jersey. The epic comedy-drama is noted as among the most heterodox of classic American comedies, as it breaks nearly every established convention of theatrical performances that was in effect when Wilder wrote it. It was produced by Michael Myerberg and directed by Elia Kazan with costumes by Mary Percy Schenck. Teething Instead, hormones are released within the body that cause some cells in the gums to die and separate, allowing the teeth to come through.
