Chikmagalur In 2022 Chikmagalur (officially Chikkamagaluru, IPA: [tʃikːemegeɭuːru]), previously known as Kiriya-Muguli, is a city, taluka and the headquarters of Chikmagalur district in the Indian state of Karnataka. has a moderate to cool climate. The pristine Baba Budangiri lies to the north of Chikmagalur, where it is believed that Baba Budan introduced coffee to India. The district was ruled by various dynasties from the 5th century onwards, important among them are Badami and Kalyan Chalukyas, Rastrakutas, Vijayanagar, Adilshahi, Mysore kingdom and Peshawas of Pune. Due to the rule of Peshwas, influence of Marathi is seen in the early decades of the 19th century. Mirabilis jalapa Mirabilis in Latin means wonderful and Jalapa (or Xalapa) is the state capital of Veracruz in Mexico. In Maharashtra it is called gulabakshi (Marathi: गुलाबक्षी). In Assam it is called godhuli gopal (Assamese: গোধুলি গোপাল), godhuli meaning "evening". Mirabilis jalapa is believed to have been cultivated by the Aztecs for medicinal and ornamental purposes. In Mirabilis jalapa, the marvel of Peru or four o'clock flower, is the most commonly grown ornamental species of Mirabilis plant, and is available in a range of colors c5e192e3f4

At the age of nine, Sambhaji was taken as a political hostage of the Mughal Empire, to guarantee his father's compliance with the treaty of Purandar. He later accompanied his father to Agra where both were placed under house arrest by the Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb; they subsequently escaped.
