

Long Term Effects Of Broken Ribs

The bean bag round typically consists of a small fabric "pillow" filled with #9 lead shot weighing about 40 grams (1.4 oz). It is fired from a normal 12-gauge shotgun. When fired, the bag is expelled at around 70 to 90 metres per second (230 to 300 ft/s); it spreads out in flight and distributes its impact over about 6 square centimetres (1 sq in) of the target.

It is designed to deliver a blow that will cause minimum long-term trauma and no penetration but will result in a muscle spasm or other reaction to briefly render a violent suspect immobile. It still can cause serious injury and death. The shotgun round is inaccurate over about 6 metres (20 ft) and has a maximum range of around 20 metres (70 ft). Changes to the bean bag round since its inception in the early 1970s have included a velocity reduction from 120 to 90 meters per second (400 to 300 ft/s) as well as a shift from a square shape to a more rounded sock-shaped projectile. 047c049eaf

The procedure is performed under general anesthesia with double-lumen intubation, and commonly with epidural analgesia set up pre-sedation for postoperative pain management.

The procedure starts with controlled cutting through the skin, intercostal muscles and then parietal pleura, and typically involves transecting at least one rib with a costotome due to the limited range of bucket handle movement each rib has without fracturing. The incised wound is then spread and held apart with a retractor (rib spreader) to allow passage of surgical instruments and the surgeon's hand. Traditional thoracotomy is thus a highly invasive procedure, with bacterial pneumonia, hemothorax/pleural effusion/air leak and intercostal neuralgia being common postoperative complications. Hebner debuted as a professional wrestling referee in the late 1970s in the Richmond, Virginia area. In 1985, he began working for the World Wrestling Federation, where he refereed many historic matches such as Randy Savage versus Ricky Steamboat at WrestleMania III and Randy Savage versus Hulk Hogan at WrestleMania V. Perhaps his most memorable appearance came on the February 5, 1988 episode of WWF The Main Event, when he was assigned to referee a match for the WWF World Heavyweight Championship between Hulk Hogan and André the Giant. André defeated Hogan after Hebner's twin brother, Earl, had switched places as Ted DiBiase had locked Dave in a closet. Earl Hebner quickly counted to three as André pinned Hogan, despite Hogan clearly having his shoulder up. The match and the WWF Championship were awarded to André as a result.
