Mecopterans are sometimes called scorpionflies after their largest family, Panorpidae, in which the males have enlarged genitals raised over the body that look similar to the stingers of scorpions, and long beaklike rostra. In contrast, the majority of species in the order inhabit moist environments in tropical locations. The Bittacidae, or hangingflies, are another prominent family and are known for their elaborate mating rituals, in which females choose mates based on the quality of gift prey offered to them by the males. A smaller group is the snow scorpionflies, family Boreidae, adults of which are sometimes seen walking on snowfields. such as leaf litter or moss, and the eggs may not hatch until the wet season arrives 9cb32867f4

Tungiasis Desquamation of the skin is always seen, especially after the flea expands during hypertrophy Tungiasis is an inflammatory skin disease caused by infection with the female ectoparasitic Tunga penetrans, a flea also known as the chigoe, chigo, chigoe flea, chigo flea, jigger, nigua, sand flea, or burrowing flea (and not to be confused with the chigger, a different arthropod). Tunga penetrans is the smallest known flea, measuring 1 mm across. It is also known in Latin America as the nigua and bicho de pie (Spanish) or bicho de pé (Portuguese), literally "foot bug". The flea and the disease that it causes are found in the tropical parts of Africa, the Caribbean, Central and South America, and India. Flea Fleas live by ingesting the blood of their hosts. and climatic conditions. Their claws keep them from being dislodged, and their mouthparts are adapted for piercing skin and sucking blood. The number of eggs laid depends on species Flea, the common name for the order Siphonaptera, includes 2,500 species of small flightless insects that live as external parasites of mammals and birds. Flea larvae are worm-like, with no limbs; they have chewing mouthparts and feed on organic debris left on their hosts' skin. They lack wings; their hind legs are extremely well adapted for jumping. Flea populations consist of roughly 50% eggs, 35% larvae, 10% pupae, and 5% adults. Adult fleas grow to about 3 millimetres (1⁄8 inch) long, are usually dark in color, and have bodies that are "flattened" sideways or narrow, enabling them to move through their hosts' fur or feathers. Some species can leap 50 times their body length, a feat second only to jumps made by another group of insects, the superfamily of froghoppers 9cb32867f4
