Stock split A stock split or stock divide increases the number of shares in a company. A stock split causes a decrease of market price of individual shares, but does not change the total market capitalization of the company: stock dilution does not occur. For example, after a 2-for-1 split, each investor will own double the number of shares, and each share will be worth half as much. In China, for example, it is common for initial public offerings of large companies to have an offer price of 10-40 Rmb per share, the equivalent of US\$1.50-5.50 per share. For example, Yonz Technology Co. Ltd. raised US\$191 million by going public on the Shanghai Stock Exchange in June 2024 at an offer price of 23.35 Rmb per share, the equivalent of a little over US\$3.00 per share. 1e6c316fe8

If some investors are... 1e6c316fe8 The legality of bump stocks in the United States came under question following the 2017 Las Vegas shooting, in which 60 people were killed and 867 people injured. The gunman was found to have fitted bump stocks to his weapons, though no evidence was reported in which any of these specific weapons were actually used in the shooting. Several states passed legislation restricting ownership of bump stocks following this shooting. In December 2018, the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) published a rule that bump stocks constituted "machine guns", and thus were illegal under federal law. The Supreme Court vacated this regulation in June 2024 in *Garland v. Cargill*. Bump stocks remain illegal in 15 states and the District of Columbia based on state bans not affected by the Supreme Court ruling. 1e6c316fe8

A Reverse Morris Trust is used when a parent company has a subsidiary (sub-company) that it wants to sell in a tax-efficient manner. The parent company completes a spin-off of a subsidiary to the parent company's shareholders. Under Internal Revenue Code section 355, this could be tax-free if certain criteria are met. The former subsidiary (now owned by the parent company's shareholders, but separate from the parent company) then merges with a target company to create a merged company. Under Internal Revenue Code section 368(a)(1)(A), this transaction could be largely tax-free if the former subsidiary is considered the "buyer" of the target company. One of the reasons is that a very high share price may deter small investors from buying the shares. Stock splits are usually initiated after a large run up in share price. 1e6c316fe8 The U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) uses the term "penny stock" to refer to a security, a financial instrument which represents a given financial value, issued by small public companies that trade at less than \$5 per share. Prior to the SEC's classification, penny stocks referred to shares that traded for "pennies on the dollar". 1e6c316fe8 The owners of common stock do not directly own any assets of the company; instead each stockholder owns a fractional interest in the company, which in turn owns the assets. As owners of a company, common stockholders are eligible to receive dividends from its recent or past earnings, proceeds from a sale of the company, and distributions of residual (left-over) money if it is liquidated. In

general, common stockholders have lowest priority to receive payouts from the company. They may not receive dividends until the company has met obligations on any preferred stocks it has issued, and they receive distributions in liquidation only after creditors (including employees), bondholders, and preferred stockholders have been paid. The main effect of stock splits is an increase in the liquidity of a stock: there are more buyers and sellers for 10 shares at \$10 than 1 share at \$100. Some companies avoid a stock split to obtain the opposite strategy: by refusing to split the stock and keeping the price high, they reduce trading volume. Berkshire Hathaway is a notable example of this. As of 2025, the company has never split its stock and trades at over US\$750,000. 1e6c316fe8
