Symptoms vary widely between individuals. Some have no symptoms, while for others it is a debilitating disease. Beyond bodily symptoms, endometriosis can affect a person's mental health and social life. It is not known exactly what causes the disease. PMOS is diagnosed when a woman has at least two of the following three features: irregular menstrual periods, high testosterone or related symptoms (like excess facial hair), or an excess of antral ovarian follicles on ultrasound. Persons with PMOS are not more likely than those without to have true ovarian cysts. A blood test for high levels of anti-Müllerian hormone can replace the ultrasound in the diagnosis. There is a clear genetic component, but environmental factors are also thought to contribute. PMOS occurs in between 5% and 18% of women. The disorder is linked to insulin resistance, which is made worse by obesity. Insulin resistance and related excess insulin levels increase the risk of complications such as type 2 diabetes and liver disease. For hyperthyroidism, the most common symptoms are associated with adrenergic stimulation: tachycardia (increased heart rate), palpitations, nervousness, tremor, increased blood pressure and heat intolerance. Clinical manifestations are often related to hypermetabolism (increased metabolism), excessive thyroid hormone, an increase in oxygen consumption, metabolic changes in protein metabolism, immunologic stimulation of diffuse goitre, and ocular changes (exophthalmos).
