Extractions are performed for a wide variety of reasons, but most commonly to remove teeth which have become unrestorable through tooth decay, periodontal disease, or dental trauma, especially when they are associated with toothache. Sometimes impacted wisdom teeth (wisdom teeth that are stuck and unable to grow normally into the mouth) cause recurrent infections of the gum (pericoronitis), and may be removed when other conservative treatments have failed (cleaning, antibiotics and operculectomy). In orthodontics, if the teeth are crowded, healthy teeth may be extracted (often bicuspid) to create space so the rest of the teeth can be straightened

Supporters of amalgam fillings point out that dental amalgam is safe, durable, relatively inexpensive, and easy to use. Supporters claim that it is safe, effective and long-lasting, while critics argue that amalgam is unsafe because it may cause mercury poisoning and other toxicity dc4eb008c1

It is biochemically complex because the teeth, jaws, and oral mucosa are dynamic. Processes such as bone remodeling (loss and gain of bone tissue) in the jaws and inflammation of soft tissue in response to the oral microbiota are clinically important for edentulous people. For example, bone resorption in the jaw is frequently how the teeth were able to detach in the first place. The jaw in an edentulous area undergoes further resorption even after the teeth are gone; and the insertion of dental implants can elicit new bone formation, leading to osseointegration. Human tooth Humans have four types of teeth: incisors, canines, premolars, and molars, which each have a specific function. The roots of teeth are

embedded in the maxilla (upper jaw) or the mandible (lower jaw) and are covered by gums. Though implants are the most expensive treatment Human teeth function to mechanically break down items of food by cutting and crushing them in preparation for swallowing and digesting. Teeth are made of multiple tissues of varying density and hardness. The incisors cut the food, the canines tear the food and the molars and premolars crush the food. As such, they are considered part of the human digestive system. Dental implants may be used to replace a single tooth or a series of teeth. to support the restoration dc4eb008c1

Humans, like most other mammals, are diphyodont, meaning that they develop two sets of teeth. The first set, deciduous teeth, also called "primary teeth", "baby teeth", or "milk teeth", normally eventually contains 20 teeth. Primary teeth typically start to appear ("erupt") around six months of age and this may be distracting and/or painful for the infant. However, some babies are born with one or more visible teeth, known as neonatal teeth or "natal teeth". dc4eb008c1

Dental restoration There are two broad categories of fillings: direct restorations Dental restoration, dental fillings, or simply fillings are dentistry treatments used to restore the function, integrity, and morphology of tooth structure lost due to decay (caries), trauma, or wear. There are two broad categories of fillings: direct restorations, placed and shaped directly inside a cleaned cavity in a single dental visit, and indirect restorations (such as inlays or onlays), which are fabricated outside the mouth (often in a laboratory) and then cemented into the tooth. tooth structure around dental implants or after more extensive procedures such as root-canal therapy. Fillings may also be used to replace or seal tooth structure around dental implants or after more extensive procedures such as root-canal therapy. Materials for direct fillings commonly include amalgam (metal) or tooth-colored composite and glass-ionomer, while indirect restorations may use ceramics, metal alloys or porcelain for greater durability and structural support dc4eb008c1

All-on-4 The treatment concept is a prosthodontics procedure for total rehabilitation of the edentulous (toothless) patient, or for patients with badly broken down teeth, decayed teeth, or compromised teeth due to gum disease. The name All-on-4 is a registered trademark of Nobel Biocare, used globally for both dental products and services. It consists of the rehabilitation of either edentulous or dentate maxilla and / or mandible with fixed prosthesis by placing four implants in the anterior maxilla, where bone density is higher. milled titanium bar structure to the dental implants, which helps them working together to protect the implants from failure, even after the hybrid bridge The term All-on-4, also known as All-on-Four and All-in-Four, refers to 'all' teeth being supported 'on four' dental implants.
