The ties and frictions often are variants of Japanese bondage, shibari and kinbaku from where they derived. == Whole body ties == Types == The word jockstrap has purportedly been in use at least since 1891, a likely contraction of "jockey strap", as the garment was first designed for bicycle-riding messengers and deliverymen, or 'bike jockeys'. The Bike Jockey Strap was the first jockstrap manufactured in America in 1874. == Design and use == Velcro watch straps (SEB 12100030 CF 55052-5 S/N 120) supplied by Omega Watch Co. and American Velcro Inc were first used for Project Mercury NASA space missions. In the US, regulations establish requirements for the identification, condition, and safe use of tie-down devices, and requires that tie-down assemblies, including synthetic web tie-downs such as ratchet straps, have a manufacturer-assigned working load limit (WLL) that is permanently marked or otherwise identifiable. Watch straps may close with a buckle or a folding clasp. Expanding watch straps are designed to expand elastically, often by the use of metal springs in a segmented design, and may be slipped on like a bracelet. Web lashing assembly They typically incorporate a tensioning mechanism, such as a ratchet, to apply pre-tension and maintain the load securely during transport. Such assemblies are made from man-made fibre webbing and include end fittings that allow the assembly to attach to anchor points, loop over cargo, or connect directly to the cargo. The common cable tie, normally made of nylon, has a flexible tape section with teeth that engage with a pawl in the head to form a ratchet, so that as the free end of the tape section is pulled the cable tie tightens and does not come undone. When the mouthpiece is inserted through the grooves and pulled tight, it creates a secure, adjustable loop, which locks in place like a knot. Some ties include a tab that can be depressed to release the ratchet so that the tie can be loosened or removed, and possibly reused. Stainless steel versions, some coated with rugged plastic, have been developed for exterior applications and hazardous environments. == Components == Over-arm straps involves tying a person's wrists behind their head, then securing the waist or other areas with the strap. A simple over-arm strap can be used for tickling, preventing the bound person from protecting their ticklish spots (such as the armpits or ribs). The edge of the cam lever that faces the webbing is usually knurled to provide a firmer grip on the webbing. Tension is added by pulling the excess webbing through the fastener until

the necessary tension is achieved and then releasing the cam lever to lock the webbing in place.
