== Series overview == Mary Eliza Mahoney was born on May 7, 1845, in Dorchester, Massachusetts, the daughter of freeborn parents, Charles Mahoney, Sr. of Maryland and... Jacqueline Flindall was born in London on 12 October 1932. She attended a Welsh boarding school in Ashford, Middlesex which was evacuated to Powis Castle in Welshpool during World War II. Flindall undertook General Nurse training at UCLH (University College Hospital London), obtaining State Registration in 1953; she also undertook Midwifery training. Subsequently, she took part in a one year exchange program with Mount Sinai Hospital in New York focusing on obstetrics and the Special Care Baby Unit. Upon her return to the UK, she became a night sister and then a ward sister at UCLH. Between 1964 and 1965, while still at UCLH, she studied for a Diploma in Public Health Nursing via Battersea College of Technology. Thereafter, she achieved a Diploma in Medical Nursing at the University of London. She also undertook the Clinical Teachers Course at the Royal College of Nursing. In 1969, Flindall was among winners of an award offered by the British Commonwealth Nurses War Memorial Fund to study in North America.

In 1908, Martha Minerva Franklin and Adah B. Thoms, two of Mahoney's colleagues, met in New York City to found the National Association of Colored Graduate Nurses (NACGN). Mahoney, Franklin, and Thoms worked to improve access to educational and nursing practices and to raise standards of living for African American registered nurses. The NACGN played a foundational role in eliminating racial discrimination in the registered nursing profession. History of nursing in the United Kingdom The establishment of the Nightingale Training School at St Thomas' Hospital in 1860 marked the beginning of organised nursing education in the UK and preceded similar developments across the country. Developing from a tradition of monastic infirmaries, nursing as a profession was popularised most in the 19th century by Florence Nightingale, who alongside others sought to introduce a formally trained caring profession to complement medicine. Since then there has been a shift towards nursing being a graduate profession; all UK pre-registration nursing programmes being at undergraduate degree level from 2013 with an emphasis on evidence-based practice. The profession matured throughout the 20th century, with state registration introduced by the Nurses Registration Act 1919 and a royal college established in 1928. The Nurse-Family Partnership program originated from a randomized controlled trial. The trial was conducted in a predominantly white, low-income neighborhood, located in Elmira, New York, in the late 1970s. For three consecutive decades, Professor David Olds and his colleagues conducted three similar randomized control trials, gathering research from each trial, which later contributed to the evidence-based development of the NFP. Randomized controlled trials were conducted in Elmira, New York; Memphis, Tennessee; and Denver, Colorado. The outcome of these trials proved that the NFP provided a tremendous number of benefits to children born in poverty stricken environments (Mason, 2016). Many of the families that participate in these trials had been experiencing many adversities, traumatic lifestyles... a701cddafe The roots of Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) go back to the time after World War II. For the Dutch priest Werenfried van Straaten the Stunde Null was the starting point of his life's work. In 1947 he founded Aid to the Eastern Priests, centred in Belgium, aimed mostly at providing material and pastoral support to displaced Germans, including Catholic priests from Eastern Germany.
