Dirofilaria immitis immitis, also known as heartworm or dog heartworm, is a parasitic roundworm that is a type of filarial worm, a small thread-like worm, and which causes dirofilariasis. The definitive host is the dog, but it can also infect cats, wolves, coyotes, jackals, foxes, ferrets, bears, seals, sea lions, and, under rare circumstances, humans. It is spread from host to host through the bites of mosquitoes. Four genera of mosquitoes transmit dirofilariasis, Aedes, Culex, Anopheles, and Mansonia

Bowman, Cornell University == History == Adult heartworms often reside in the pulmonary arterial system (lung arteries) as well as the heart, and a major health effect in the infected animal host is damage to its lung vessels and tissues. Heartworm infection may result in serious complications for the infected host if left untreated, eventually leading to death, most often as a result of secondary congestive heart failure. Selamectin is applied topically. It is not miscible in water.

Acanthocheilonema Many species among several genera of filarioids exhibit a high degree of endemicity in studies done on mammalian species in Japan. Cobbold created the genus Acanthocheilonema with only one species, Acanthocheilonema dracunculoides, which was collected from aardwolf (Proteles cristatus: Hyaenidae) in the region of South Africa in the nineteenth century. This transmission is usually carried out by the flea species and lice Acanthocheilonema is a genus within the family Onchocercidae which comprises mainly tropical parasitic worms. These parasites have a wide range of mammalian species as hosts, including members of Carnivora, Macroscelidea, Rodentia, Pholidota, Edentata, and Marsupialia. Dogs are frequently parasitized by the filarids. However, no concrete evidence has confirmed any endemic species in the genus Acanthocheilonema. species and around different continents db7af91e84

Nematode infection in dogs Heartworm control in Germany only plays a role in dogs that are to be taken to endemic foreign countries (including southern and eastern European Nematode infection in dogs - the infection (also infestation) of dogs with parasitic nematodes - are, along with tapeworm infections and infections with protozoa (giardiasis, neosporosis), frequent parasitoses in veterinary practice. Nematodes, as so-called endoparasites ("internal parasites"), colonize various internal organs - most of them the digestive tract - and the skin. For most nematodes, an infection can be detected by examining the feces for eggs or larvae. Roundworm infection in dogs and the hookworm in dogs is of particular health significance in Central Europe, as they can also be transmitted to humans (zoonosis). To date, about 30 different species of nematode have been identified in domestic dogs; they are essentially also found in wild dog species. The infection therefore does not necessarily have to manifest itself in a worm disease (helminthosis). However, the majority of them often cause no or only minor symptoms of disease in adult animals. Regular deworming can significantly reduce the frequency of infection and thus the risk of infection for humans and dogs. unborn puppies db7af91e84

[citation needed] It Selamectin, sold under the brand name Revolution, among others, is a topical parasiticide and anthelmintic used on dogs and cats. It is structurally related to ivermectin and milbemycin. It is used for prevention of heartworm disease caused by *Dirofilaria immitis*; treat and prevent flea infestations; treat and control tick infestations with the lone star tick, Gulf Coast tick, American dog tick, black-legged tick, and brown dog tick; and treat and control roundworm and adult hookworm infections. db7af91e84 The feline combination antiparasitic Revolution Plus (or Stronghold Plus) contains sarolaner and selamectin and is used for prevention of sarcoptic mange, feline hookworms, feline roundworms, ear mites, and heartworms, as well as treating and preventing fleas and ticks. db7af91e84 Dog health is viewed holistically; it encompasses many different aspects, including disease processes, genetics, and nutritional health, for example.
