Tea blending and additives Ginseng: Teas blended with ginseng are popular in China, where ginseng is an important root in Traditional Tea blending is the act of blending different teas (and sometimes other products) to produce a final product that differs in flavor from the original tea used. contains additional lemon peel and orange peel. The most prominent type of tea blending is commercial tea blending, which is used to ensure consistency of a batch on a mass scale so that

any variations between different batches and seasons of tea production do not affect the final product. Commercially, it is considered important that any batch of a particular blend must taste the same as the previous batch, so a consumer will not be able to detect a difference in flavor from one purchase to the next. This occurs chiefly with black tea, which is blended to make most tea bags, but it can also occur with such teas as Pu-erh, where leaves are blended from different regions before being compressed 2466a59f75

Ginger is in the family Zingiberaceae, which also includes turmeric (*Curcuma longa*), cardamom (*Elettaria cardamomum*), and galangal. Ginger originated in Maritime Southeast Asia and was likely domesticated first by the Austronesian peoples. It was transported with them throughout the Indo-Pacific during the Austronesian expansion (c. 5,000 BP), reaching as far as Hawaii. Ginger is one of the first spices to have been exported from Asia, arriving in Europe with the spice trade, and was used by ancient Greeks and Romans. Ginger ale is transparent, whereas ginger beer, a stronger tasting product, is often cloudy due to the residues of brewing. Thomas Joseph Cantrell, an Irish apothecary and surgeon, manufactured the first ginger ale in Belfast, Ireland, in the 1850s. He set out to create a soft drink. This was the older "golden style" fermented ginger ale, dark coloured, generally sweet to taste, with a strong

ginger spice flavour, which he marketed through local beverage manufacturer Grattan and Company. Grattan embossed the slogan "The Original Makers of Ginger Ale" on its bottles. 2466a59f75

Ginger ale Traditional ginger ale is fermented from a microbial starter culture (yeast or ginger bug), sugar, fresh ginger root, other flavourings and water. The dry style (also called the pale style), a paler drink with a much milder ginger flavour, was created by Canadian John McLaughlin. Ginger bug Ginger ale is a carbonated soft drink (not an ale) flavoured with ginger. The golden style is credited to the Irish doctor Thomas Joseph Cantrell. There are two main types of ginger ale.
