CAMP test Though not strongly beta-hemolytic on its own, group B strep presents with wedge-shaped The CAMP test (Christie–Atkins–Munch–Petersen) is a test to identify group B β -hemolytic streptococci (*Streptococcus agalactiae*) based on their formation of a substance, CAMP factor, that enlarges the area of hemolysis formed by the β -hemolysin elaborated from *Staphylococcus aureus*. *henselae*. CAMP factor is a phospholipase produced by Group B Streptococci (*Streptococcus agalactiae*) that enhances hemolysis of *Staphylococcus aureus*. ee708868c0 The term was coined in 1877 by Viennese surgeon Albert Theodor Billroth (1829–1894), from Ancient Greek στρεπτός (*streptós*), meaning "twisted", and κόκκος (*kókkos*), meaning "grain". In 1984, many bacteria formerly grouped in the genus *Streptococcus* were separated out into the genera *Enterococcus* and *Lactococcus*. Currently, over 50 species are recognised in this genus. ee708868c0

S. agalactiae was recognized as a pathogen in cattle by Edmond Nocard and Mollereau in the late 1880s. It can cause bovine mastitis (inflammation of the udder) in dairy cows. The species name "agalactiae" meaning "no milk", alludes to this. Its significance as a human pathogen was first described in 1938, and in the early 1960s, GBS came to be recognized as a major cause of infections in newborns. In most people, *Streptococcus agalactiae* is a harmless commensal bacterium that is part of the normal human microbiota colonizing... ee708868c0 The plural term group B streptococci (referring to the serotypes) and the singular term group B streptococcus (referring to the single species) are both commonly used synonymously with *S. agalactiae* even though *S. halichoeri* and *S. pseudoporcinus* are also group B *Streptococcus*. Most streptococci are oxidase-negative and catalase-negative, and many are facultative anaerobes (capable of growth both aerobically and anaerobically)

Use in pregnancy and breastfeeding is believed to be safe but has not been well studied. The main criterion for differentiation between Staphylococcus spp. and Streptococcus spp. is the catalase test. Staphylococci are catalase positive whereas streptococci are catalase-negative. S. pyogenes can be cultured on fresh blood agar plates. The PYR test allows for the differentiation of Streptococcus pyogenes from other morphologically similar beta-hemolytic streptococci (including... A similar factor has been identified in Bartonella henselae. S. agalactiae is the most common human pathogen of streptococci belonging to group B of the Rebecca Lancefield classification of streptococci. GBS are surrounded by a bacterial capsule composed of polysaccharides (exopolysaccharide). The species is subclassified into ten serotypes (Ia, Ib, II-IX) depending on the immunologic reactivity of their polysaccharide capsule. The most severe form of group B streptococcal disease is neonatal meningitis in infants, which is frequently lethal and can cause permanent neuro-cognitive impairment.

Streptococcus pyogenes [citation needed] In rare cases, strep throat can develop into a condition known as scarlet Streptococcus pyogenes is a species of Gram-positive, aerotolerant bacteria in the genus Streptococcus. They are clinically important for humans, as they are an infrequent, but usually pathogenic, part of the skin microbiota that can cause group A streptococcal infection. The name group A (beta-hemolytic) Streptococcus is thus also used. pyogenes causes pharyngitis which is also known as strep throat. pyogenes is the predominant species harboring the Lancefield group A antigen, and is often called group A Streptococcus (GAS).
