The disease causes progressive muscle loss with weakness, fasciculations, and cramps. Weakness of the bulbar muscles follows causing difficulties in speech (dysarthria) and swallowing (dysphagia). Female carriers do not show symptoms. Although there is no cure, supportive intervention can improve mobility and reduce complications. The prevalence of SBMA has been estimated at 2.6:100,000 males. ee306f85da

== Signs and symptoms == ee306f85da In terms of health benefits, usually, 150 minutes (2 hours and 30 minutes) of

Libido The term was originally developed by the Austrian neurologist Sigmund Freud, the pioneer of psychoanalysis. The libido or sex drive (/lɪˈbiːdoʊ/ lih-BEE-doh; from Latin libīdō, "lust, desire") refers to a psychological energy that, in common parlance, encompasses The libido or sex drive (lih-BEE-doh; from Latin libīdō, "lust, desire") refers to a psychological energy that, in common parlance, encompasses all forms of sexual desire, but is sometimes also regarded as the driving force behind other needs, such as a mother's love for her infant. As driving energy behind all life processes, libido became the source of the social engagement (maternal love instinct, for example), sexual behaviour, pursuit for nutrition, skin pleasure, knowledge and victory in all areas of self- and species preservation. Initially it referred only to specific sexual needs, but he later expanded the concept to a universal desire, with the id being its "great reservoir" ee306f85da

Sex after pregnancy Common issues that may last more than a year after birth are greater desire by the man than the woman, and a worsening of the woman's body image. Painful intercourse is the most common sexual activity-related complication after childbirth. Injury to the perineum or surgical cuts (episiotomy) to the vagina during childbirth can cause sexual dysfunction. Women often have a poor body image Sex after pregnancy is often delayed for several weeks or months, and may be difficult and painful for women. first-time mothers report a loss of libido at eight months, though only 1 in 7 of experienced mothers have a loss of libido. Sexual activity in the postpartum period other than sexual intercourse is possible sooner, but some women experience a prolonged loss of sexual desire after giving birth, which may be associated with postnatal depression. Since there are no guidelines on resuming sexual intercourse after childbirth, the postpartum patients are generally advised to resume sex when they feel comfortable to do so ee306f85da

In their late 40s and early 50s, some men may experience depression, loss of libido, erectile dysfunction, and other physical and emotional symptoms. These symptoms include irritability, loss of muscle mass and reduced ability to exercise, weight gain, lack

of energy, difficulty sleeping, and poor concentration. Many of these symptoms may arise from a midlife crisis or as the results of a long-term unhealthy lifestyle (smoking, excess drinking, overeating, lack of exercise) and may be best addressed by lifestyle changes, therapy... ee306f85da Prolactin (PRL) is a peptide hormone produced by lactotroph cells in the anterior pituitary gland. It plays a vital role in lactation and breast development. Hyperprolactinemia, characterized by abnormally high levels of prolactin, may cause galactorrhea (production and spontaneous flow of breast milk), infertility, and menstrual disruptions in women. In men, it can lead to hypogonadism, infertility and erectile dysfunction. ee306f85da

Androgen Androgens are the precursors to estrogens in all humans An androgen (from Greek andr-, the stem of the word meaning 'man') is any natural or synthetic steroid hormone that regulates the development and maintenance of male physiological characteristics in vertebrates by binding to androgen receptors. hormones, females also have them, but at lower levels: they function in libido and sexual arousal. This includes the embryological development of the primary male sex organs, and the development of male secondary sex characteristics at puberty. Androgens are synthesized in the testes, the ovaries, and the adrenal glands ee306f85da

Equating the libido with the Eros of Platonic philosophy, Freud further differentiated two inherent operators: the life drive and the death drive. Together with estrogen, progesterone, insulin-like growth factor-1 (IGF-1), and hormones from the placenta, prolactin stimulates the proliferation of breast alveolar elements during pregnancy. However, lactation is inhibited during pregnancy due to elevated estrogen levels. Hyperprolactinaemia The upper normal limit of serum prolactin is

typically between 15 and 25 ng/mL for both men and women. In women, normal prolactin levels average to about 13 ng/mL, while in men, they average 5 ng/mL. Increased prolactin can affect the inhibition of GnRH secretion, which is responsible for libido, and the release of FSH (Follicle-stimulating Hyperprolactinaemia (also spelled hyperprolactinemia) is a condition characterized by abnormally high levels of prolactin in the blood. Levels exceeding this range indicate hyperprolactinemia. the onset of the condition ee306f85da

Androgens increase in both males and females during puberty. The major androgen in males is testosterone. Dihydrotestosterone (DHT) and androstenedione are of equal importance in male development. DHT in utero causes differentiation of the penis, scrotum and prostate. Prolactinoma It is the most common type of functioning pituitary tumor. The symptoms due to a prolactinoma are broadly divided into those that are caused by increased prolactin levels and those A prolactinoma is a tumor (adenoma) of the pituitary gland that produces the hormone prolactin. disruptions such as a loss of libido. Based on its size, a prolactinoma may be classified as a microprolactinoma (<10mm diameter) or a macroprolactinoma (>10mm diameter). Symptoms of prolactinoma are due to abnormally high levels of prolactin in the blood (hyperprolactinemia), or due to pressure of the tumor on surrounding brain tissue and/or the optic nerves ee306f85da

== Definition == Neuromuscular symptoms include muscle weakness and wasting of the limb, bulbar and respiratory muscles, tremor, fasciculations, muscle cramps, speech and swallowing difficulties, decreased...
