Command-line interface Devices like the Teletype Model 33, introduced in 1963, allowed operators to type a command and receive a printed response from the computer. Before the CLI, computers were programmed using physical switches or punched cards. Early systems like the Whirlwind I (1951) at MIT began utilizing typewriter-like inputs for direct control, moving away from batch processing where you'd hand a stack of cards to an operator and wait hours for a result. Parameters: Most command-line interfaces support a means to pass additional information to a program when it is launched. Interactive command-line sessions: A command-line interface (CLI), also known as a command-line shell, is a means of interacting with software via commands - each formatted as a line of text. The shift toward a "command" style interaction began with the use of Teleprinters (Teletypes). The concept of interacting with a computer via text evolved over two decades, transitioning from physical hardware to sophisticated software e3cb713c12

== History == e3cb713c12 Within a group of people, a command hierarchy defines who carry out orders based on group members' authority. In sociology, command hierarchy is seen as the most visible element of a "power network". In this model, social

capital is viewed as being mobilized in response to orders that move through the hierarchy leading to the phrase "command and control". Four terms always associated with the command pattern are command, receiver, invoker and client. A command object knows about receiver and invokes a method of the receiver. Values for parameters of the receiver method are stored in the command. The receiver object to execute these methods is also stored in the command object by aggregation. The receiver then does the work when the execute() method in command is called. An invoker object knows how to execute a command, and optionally does bookkeeping about the command execution. The invoker does not know anything about a concrete command, it knows only about the command interface. Invoker object(s), command objects and receiver objects are held by a client object. The client decides which receiver objects it assigns to the command objects, and which commands it assigns to the invoker. The client decides which commands to... The command set covered only those operations supported by the earliest 300 bit/s modems. When new commands were required to control additional functionality in higher-speed modems, a variety of one-off standards emerged from each of the major vendors. These continued to share the basic command structure and syntax, but added any number of new commands using some sort of prefix character – & for Hayes and USRobotics, and \ for Microcom, for instance.
