It is a neurodevelopmental disorder, meaning impairing symptoms must have been present in childhood, except for when ADHD occurs after traumatic brain injury. ADHD was previously thought to be a childhood disorder that improved with age, but later research challenged this theory. This represents a change from the DSM-IV, which required symptom onset before the age of 7. Approximately two-thirds of children with ADHD continue to experience impairing symptoms into adulthood, with symptoms ranging from minor inconveniences to impairments in daily functioning, and up to one-third continue to meet the full diagnostic criteria. non-stimulant atomoxetine (Strattera) may be an effective treatment for adult ADHD. Although atomoxetine has a half-life similar to stimulants, it exhibits Adult attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (adult ADHD) is ADHD that persists into adulthood.
