Bulmer's fruit bat It is the only member of the genus Aroteles. It is not sexually active by the beginning of its second year and probably Bulmer's fruit bat (Aroteles bulmerae) is a megabat endemic to New Guinea. It is listed as a critically endangered species due to habitat loss and hunting. both in Papua New Guinea Bulmer's fruit bat lives in cave-dwelling colonies. Due to its imperiled status, it is identified by the Alliance for Zero Extinction as a species in danger of imminent extinction

Diospyros nigra Black sapote is not related to white sapote and is only distantly related to mamey sapote. The common name sapote refers to any soft, edible fruit. members of the genus *Ptilinopus* in the family *Columbidae*. Birds of this genus are typified by small to medium-sized bodies and vibrant plumage. The specific epithet *aurantiifrons* is derived from Latin *aurantius*, meaning 'orange' and *frons*, meaning 'front' or 'forehead'. The species is found across Papua New Guinea, with a range extending from sea level to 300m. The orange-fronted fruit dove is localized and is described as sedentary (non-migratory).

Description Taxonomy The orange originated in a region encompassing Southern China, Northeast India, and Myanmar; the earliest mention of the sweet orange was in Chinese literature in 314 BC.
