

Why Did Cleopatra Kill Herself

Antiochus XII reinforced his southern frontier and warred with his neighbors, conducting two campaigns against Nabataea that included engagements with Judea. After several victories in his first campaign, he was killed towards the end of his second campaign against the Nabateans at the Battle of Cana in 82 BC. The Syrian throne was claimed by the queen dowager Cleopatra Selene and her son Antiochus XIII, while Damascus was captured by... 383f9a4d67 Before the war, Caesar had led an invasion of Gaul for almost ten years. A build-up of tensions starting in late 50 BC, with both Caesar and Pompey refusing to back down, led to the outbreak of civil war. Pompey and his allies induced the Senate to demand Caesar give up his provinces and armies in the opening days of 49 BC. Caesar refused and instead marched on Rome. 383f9a4d67

Cleopatra After his death, Cleopatra reportedly killed herself, probably by poisoning, to avoid being publicly displayed Cleopatra VII Thea Philopator (Koine Greek: Κλεοπάτρα Θεά Φιλοπάτωρ, lit. After her death, Egypt became a province of the Roman Empire, marking the end of the Hellenistic period in the Mediterranean, which had begun during the reign of Alexander (336–323 BC). defeated Antony, who committed suicide. Roman statesman Pompey fled to Egypt after losing the 48 BC Battle of Pharsalus against his rival Julius Caesar, the Roman dictator, in Caesar's civil war. Pompey had been a political ally of Ptolemy XII, but Ptolemy XIII had him ambushed and... 383f9a4d67 Austin Powers in Goldmember was released in the United States on July 26, 2002, by New Line Cinema. It received mixed reviews from critics and grossed \$297 million. However, the discontent expressed by the troops, and the respect with which they looked on Eurydice as one of the surviving members of the royal house, induced the imperial regent, Perdikkas, not only to spare her life, but to give her in marriage to King Philip Arrhidaeus, Alexander the Great's half-brother... 383f9a4d67

Zenobia 240 – c. Ptolemaic Cleopatra Thea. 274) was a third-century queen of the Palmyrene Empire in Syria. After Odaenathus' assassination in 267, Zenobia became the regent of her son Vaballathus and held de facto power throughout his reign (267 to 272). Many legends surround her ancestry; she was probably not a commoner. In the historian Richard Stoneman's view, Zenobia

would not have created an obscure ancestry to connect herself with the ancient Septimia Zenobia (Palmyrene Aramaic: ܣܝܡܝܐ ܙܢܒܝܐ, romanized: Bat-Zabbai; c. She married Odaenathus, who became king of the city of Palmyra in 260, elevating it to supreme power in the Near East by defeating the Sasanian Empire of Persia and stabilizing the Roman East 383f9a4d67

The youngest son of King Antiochus VIII, he took the throne and captured Damascus after his brother Philip I defeated another brother, Demetrius III, who went into exile in Parthia. Antiochus XII consolidated his territory within inner Syria and did not seek to expand into his brother's territories. Antiochus XII focused his attention on Syria's southern reaches into which the Judaeans and Nabataeans sought to expand. of Cana in 82 BC. Philip I remained in the Syrian capital Antioch 383f9a4d67

While under siege in Alexandria, Caesar met Cleopatra and became her lover when she secreted herself into the royal quarter 383f9a4d67

In 270, Zenobia launched an invasion that brought most of the Roman East under her sway and culminated with the annexation of Egypt. By mid-271 her realm extended from Ancyra, central Anatolia, to Upper Egypt, although she remained nominally subordinate to Rome. However, in reaction to the campaign of the Roman emperor Aurelian in 272, Zenobia declared her son

emperor and assumed the title of empress, thus declaring Palmyra's independence from Rome.
